GILLIS, James* 22 Aug 1862

1st Sergt. Gillis was age 28 when he entered service. He was appointed from Sergt. on 17 Apr 1863; killed 3 May 1864 in action near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana. No burial information is given in the Roll of Honor.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: James GILLAS, Sergt, Co C 120th OH Inf, died 3 May 1864 at Regimental Hospital. Cause: g s wound [gun shot wound] Signed by Byron Stanton. [Note from researcher: In my opinion from seeing other records like this, Byron Stanton probably never saw the body of James Gillis. He probably made out this record from reports by witnesses in the regiment who were there at Snaggy Point.]

"Resolutions of the Excelsior Society of Vermillion Institute upon the Death of Jas. Gillis. Excelsior Hall, Hayesville, O., 22d July 1864.

Whereas, The members of the Excelsior Society, have received intelligence of the death of their esteemed brother and friend, James Gillis, of Company C, 120th Reg't. O. V. I., and whereas, we cherish with grateful recollections the memory of those who have gone out from this society to battle for their country.---

Therefore be it

Resolved, That in the death of James Gillis, this Society has lost one of its most worthy members and the community one [of] its most amiable citizens.

Resolved, That we sincerely mourn the loss of one whose gentlemanly deportment and upright conduct secured to him the respect and admiration of all who knew him.

Resolved, That we deeply sympathize with his afflicted friends and relatives, in this their hour of bereavement.

Resolved, That these resolutions be published in the Ashland Times, and Ashland Union and copies be furnished the parents of the deceased.

Resolved, That as a further mark of respect for the memory of the deceased, the Society do now adjourn.
