HAWKINS, John S. 12 Aug 1862 [Should be HAWKS...see pension information]

Private Hawkins was age 21 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 30 June 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Mother: Isabella NIXON

Birth: 23 Mar 1842 Ireland

Marriage: Rosina B. ???BADERS???

Death: 13 Aug 1907

Cemetery: Hennessey Cem, Hennessey, Kingfisher County, OK

Pension Index: John S HAWKS, alias John S. HAWKINS, Co C 120th OH Inf. Invalid filed 14 Feb 1888, Application 640200, Certificate 602127, filed in OH. His widow, Rosina B. HAWKS, applied for pension 23 Sep 1907, Application 876768, Certificate 636472, filed in Oklahoma. Died 1907.

1850 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 385, Family 392: George HAWK, age 44 Ireland, farmer; Isabella, age 45 Ireland; Mary Ann, age 16 Ireland; George, age 14 Ireland; Isabella, age 11 Ireland; John, age 8 Ireland; Martha, age 4 Ireland.

1860 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland County OH, page 152: George HAWKS, age 54 Ireland, farmer; Isabella, age 55 Ireland; Isabella, age 20 Ireland; John, age 18 Ireland, farm labor; Martha, age 14 Ireland.

1870 Census Clark Twp, Coshocton County, OH, page 39: J.S. HAWKS, age 28 Ireland, minister; Rosanna, age 29 OH; Samuel, age 4 OH.

1880 Census Troy, Morrow County, OH, page 335: John S HAWKES, age 38 Ireland, minister, parents born Ireland; Rosana, wife, age 39 OH, parents born Baden; Samuel A, son, age 14 OH; Belle C, daughter, age 2 OH; Syvester SWISSGOOD, "other", age 18 OH, works on farm, parents born OH.

?????????Family Search: Ohio, Births and Christenings, 1821-1962: Anna HAWKS born 25 Oct 1881, Carey, Wyandot Co, OH. Father John S. HAWKS. Mother Rosa B. BADERS.

Have not found in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Census Hennessey Twp, Kingfisher County, OK, page 133: John S HAWKS, age 57 Ireland, born 23 Mar 1841?, married 30 yrs, minister Cong.; RsanaB, wife, age 59? OH, born 18? or 1st? Apr 1841, married 30 yrs, 6 children/3 still living, parents born Germany; George, son, age 15 OH, born 11th? July 1884, farm laborer. [Family Search: It looks like son George M. was married twice, Mary FLUMMERFELT and Elva S. PARKS, but neither record gives his mother's maiden name.]

Sons of Union Veterans: Born 23 Mar 1842. Died 13 Aug 1907. Burial Hennessey Cem, Hennessey, Kingfisher County, OK

MUNCH, age 37 KS, first marriage, married 10 yrs, parents born OH, clerk in hardware store; Belle, wife, age 32 OH, first marriage, married 10 yrs, 2 children/2 still living, father born Ireland, mother born OH; Verna R, daughter, age 9 OK; Francis P, son, age 3 OK; Roseina B HAWKS, mother in law, age 69 OH, widow, 6 children/3 still living, parents born Switzerland, own income.

Rosina B. died 19 Feb 1918. [Cemetery memorial stone]

Sister's Death record in Ohio: File #119: Mary Ann JACKMAN died 2 Jan 1920 at Hayesville, Ashland Co OH. Widow. Born 24 May 1833 in Ireland. Father, George HAWKS, born Ireland. Mother Isabel NIXON, born Ireland. Burial Hayesville, OH. Informant Miss Belle HAWKS of Hayesville, OH.
