MILLER, Lewis W.* 20 Aug 1862

Private Miller was age 19 when he entered service. He died on 23 Mar 1863 at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Lewis W. MILLER, Private, Co C 120th OH Inf, died 22 Mar 1863 on floating hospital "Nashville" Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

Have not found on Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

Not found in Pension Index.

I need some clues here. Father might have been Tobias Miller of Mahoning Co OH in 1850.

???1850 Census, Jackson, Mahoning Co OH, Dwelling 661, Family 661: Tobias MILLER, age 40 PA, farmer; Susanna, age 37 PA; Lubet [male] age 14 OH; Elizabeth, age 12 OH; Susanna, age 11 OH; Lydia, age 9 OH; Lewis, age 7 OH; Catharine, age 5 OH; Samuel, age one OH. But Lewis was listed as Levi in the next 1860 census.

?1860 Census, Ashland, Ashland County, OH, page 86: There is a Louis MILLER, age 17 OH, no occupation listed, living at what appears to be a hotel whose proprietor is Michael MILLER, age 40 France.
