Private Morgan's age upon entering service was not given in the Roster. He died on 20 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

But there is no Benjamin MORGAN in Co C of the 128th OH or in the 128th at all and also not listed in the 12th OH Inf. So, I believe this is Benjamin MORGAN of Co C 120<sup>th</sup> OVI.
