Private Morris was age 19 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. H 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. 14 Oct 1865 transferred to Co B, 48th OVI. Mustered out 9 May 1866. [Pension Index also indicates Co B 48th Ohio]
