RISSER, Joseph\* 22 Aug 1862

Private Risser was age 22 when he entered service. He died 11 Aug 1863 at Port Hudson, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at Port Hudson, Louisiana.

1860 Census, Vermillion Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 130: John RISSER Sr., age 73 Germany, farmer; Catharine, age 30 Germany, Amelia, age 9 OH; Mary, age 5 OH; Jacob, age 3 OH; Augusta, age 1 OH; Joseph, age 20 OH, farm laborer; Barbara, age 21 OH. [Note: This immediately follows the Jacob RISSER [age 65] and Mary RISSER [age 59] family. So Jacob and Mary may be the parents of Joseph RISSER.]

[Jacob \[d. 1871\] and Mary \[d. 1864-1866\] RISSER](#) are buried at Strickland Cemetery, Hayesville, Ashland Co OH.
