SEIBERT, Joseph D.* 20 Aug 1862

Corporal Seibert was age 19 when he entered service. He was killed 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana. No burial information is given in the Roll of Honor.

Joseph D. Seibert was shot while color bearer on the boat, City Bell, while on the Red River expedition under General Banks.
