SHAMBAUGH, Henry* 16 Aug 1862

Private Henry Shambaugh was age 26 when he entered service. He died 24 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says that he is buried at St. Louis, Missouri in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery.

Father: Christian Shambach

Mother: Mary Walter

Birth: 7 April 1836

Marriage: apparently single

Death: 24 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, LA [or 2 Feb 1863 at hospital in St. Louis]

Cemetery: Jefferson Barracks Cemetery, St Louis Co, MO [Not listed at Interment or Nationwide Gravesite Locator] He is buried at Middleburgh, Snyder co PA, 9 March 1863. See [Find a Grave](#)

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Henry SHAMBAUGH, Private, Co C 120th OH Inf. died 1 Feb 1863 at New Hospital of Refuge General Hospital St. Louis, MO. Cause: chronic dysentery.

Have not found in Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

I just don't know what family Henry belongs to.

Note: Found an H SHAMBAUGH, age 19 OH living in Green Twp, Ashland County OH in 1850 with the A Royer family on pages 111 a and b right next to the family of William SHAMBAUGH also of Company C. However, the age does not quite match.

Lists **Henry's parents as Christian Shambach** who was born in Montgomery County and **Mary Walter** in Snyder county. She was the daughter of David and Susan Eberhart Walter. He was a farmer and wagon maker. **Henry's siblings** were Daniel, David, George, Mary Polly, Jesse, Isaac, Jacob, Elizabeth, John, William, and Lydia. Henry was the youngest. His father married a second time to Mrs. Elizabeth Betchel Bilger [widow of Isaac Bilger] and had Harriet, Aaron, Sevilla and Sarah.

The article says that Henry was born April 7, 1836, and died 2 Feb 1863. He was a member of Co. C, 120th Ohio Regt. He died in the hospital in St. Louis, Mo. and was buried in Middleburg, March 9, 1863.
