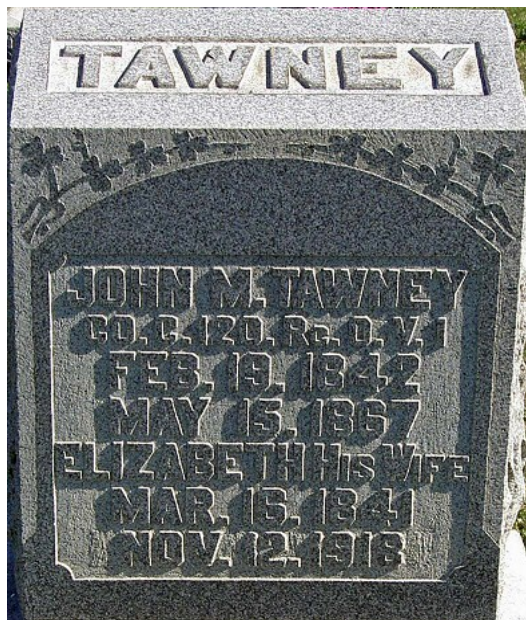

TANNEY, John 12 Aug 1862 John TAWNEY
Private Tanney was age 20 when he entered service. He was wounded 29 Dec 1862 in the battle of Chickasaw Bayou, Mississippi; discharged 20 Mar 1863 at Paducah, Kentucky.

[Pension index also indicates Co B 186th Ohio Infantry...this regiment served from Feb until Sept 1865.]

Listed in the Wooster Republican on 29 January 1863: In St. Marks Hospital, Paducah, Ky. L.S. Holton surgeon in charge: John Tawny, 120th, [wounded] slightly. [since there is no John Tawny listed, this may be another spelling for Tanney]

Father: Michael TAWNEY

Mother: Catherine DEHAVEN

Birth: 19 Feb 1842 [Cemetery stone]

Marriage: Elizabeth LATIMER

Death: 15 May 1867 [Cemetery stone]

Cemetery: Hayesville Vermillion Cemetery

Relationship: Brother of Thomas C. TAWNEY of Co C, 120th OVI

Pension Index: John M TAWNEY, C 120th and B 186th OH Inf, applied for invalid's pension unknown. His widow, Elizabeth TAWNEY, applied for pension 13 May 1872, Application 203454, Certificate 260202. Minor application must have been made 11 Dec 1888, Application 390072, Certificate 260203, by John M TAWNEY. [Note: the two pension cards I found had conflicting information.]

1850 Census, Green Twp, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 252, Family 253: Michael TAWNEY, age 46 PA, farmer; Catharine, age 43 PA; Thomas, age 19 OH, farmer; Rebecca, age 18 OH; [next page] Catharine, age 13 OH; Elisabeth, age 11 OH; John, age 8 OH; Sephia, age 5 OH [female]; Mary, age 4 OH; David, age 1 OH.

1860 Census, Green Twp, Ashland County, OH, page 290: Michael TAWNEY, age 56 PA, farmer and blacksmith; Catherine, age 53 PA; John, age 18 OH; Sophia, age 16 OH; Mary A, age 13 OH; Danel, age 11 OH; Alice, age 7 OH; Thomas TAWNEY, age 23 OH [see soldier below]. [[Michael TAWNEY](#) died 1882, buried at Bethesda Cem, Ashland Co OH.]

Parents Michael TAWNEY and Catherine DEHAVEN, born PA. Burial Shambaugh Cemetery, Richland Co OH. Informant, Mrs. A? N. SCHUCK, of Ashland OH RFD9
