WEATHERBEE, Lucius M. B. 22 Aug 1862 Lucius Marcus WEATHERBEE

Private Lucius Weatherbee was age 23 when he entered service. [No further information given.] [Note: According to the 1910 census Lucius served in the Confederacy; the CA on the census record could be a mistake but this other "evidence" makes me think it was not.] [1890 Veterans Schedule: Chehalis, Lewis Co WA: "Erased by supervisor" Line 14, House 249, Family 254: Lucius M. WEATHERBEE, Pvt. Lous. Post Office: Chehalis, Lewis Co, WA.] **Does "Lous." stand for Louisiana? It certainly doesn't stand for Ohio. DID LUCIUS SWITCH SIDES AND JOIN THE CONFEDERACY?**

[Note: Wayne County Probate Court record: Justus S WEATHERBY married Ann Maria LYBARGER on 14 Feb 1833 in Wayne County OH.]

1900 Census, Coal Crk Pct, Lewis County, WA, page 120: Lucius WEATHERBEE, age 62 OH, married 29 yrs, born Oct 1837, farmer, father born NY, mother born PA; Adaline, wife, age 47 PA, born May 1853, married 29 yrs, 9 children/7 still living, father born NY, mother born PA; Lee, son, age 28 MO, single, born Dec 1871 day laborer; May, daughter, age 25 MO, single, born May 1875; Claud, son, age 18 MO, single, born May 1882, day laborer; Orra?, son, age 15 MO, born Feb 1885, farm laborer; Thomas, son, age 11 MO, born Oct 1888, farm laborer; Jessie, daughter, age 9 WA, born Aug 1890; Vera, daughter, age 6 WA, born Oct 1893.

1910 Census, Cedar Ave, 3rd Ward Everett, Snohomish County, WA, page 94: Lucius M WEATHERBEE, age 72 OH, first marriage, married 40 yrs, father born NY, mother born PA, has no occupation, **Column 30 says CA for service in the Confederate army**; Adeline E, wife, age 59 PA, first marriage, married 40 yrs, 9 children/7 still living, parents born USA; Mae, daughter, age 30 MO, single, clerk county commissioner; Claud R, son, age 26 MO, single, laborer lumber mill; Jackson, son, age 25 MO, single, odd jobs; Thomas R, son, age 22 MO, single, fisherman own boat; Josephine E, daughter, age 19 WA, single, milliner in millinery store; Vera M, daughter, age 16 WA, single. [Note: Vera M WEATHERBEE married Harold W PORTER in Snohomish co WA on 19 June 1913.

Lucius and Adeline are not listed in 1920 in Washington that I have found. Claud and May are in Seattle, WA. Josephine is in Centralia WA. No parents living with Vera Porter in 1920.

1890 Special Schedule show the line scratched out by the Supervisor and has "Lous" in the column that should have OH if he were in an Ohio regiment.

The 1910 census in green and yellow shows CA in the column that should have UA. CA stands for Confederate Army.
