BAKER, John 15 Oct 1862 [Note: There is also another John BAKER in [Company H.](#)]
Private Baker was age 28 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.
