

## Company D, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

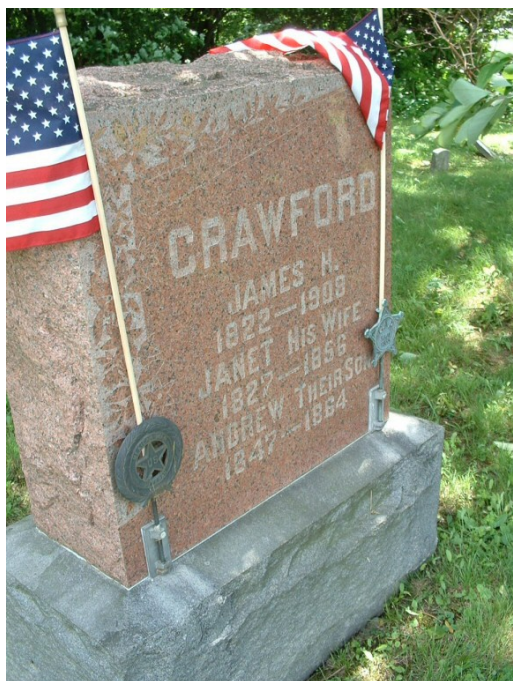

CRAWFORD, Andrew 22 Aug 1862

Private Crawford was age 18 [he was probably younger...age 15 maybe] when he entered service. He was discharged on 24 Sept 1864 at St. Charles, Arkansas on a Surgeon's Certificate of Disability.

"List of Casualties...while on board the Steamer 'City Belle' near 'Snaggy Point' La, May 3d 1864..." Private A. CRAWFORD, missing, condition not known. [From the records of the Ohio Adjutant General, available at the Ohio Historical Society, Columbus, Ohio. Contributed by Kerry Kimberly]

Thanks to Kerrie Alexander for some of the information about Andrew Crawford and his family. Kerrie is Andrew's first cousin 3 times removed, related through Andrew's mother's line.

James, Janet and their son Andrew are on one stone and there is an older stone for Andrew.

Civil War veteran, Andrew Crawford, is buried in Yost cemetery, Wayne county, OH. St. Joseph Cemetery on Sterling Rd, south of Burbank. 1847-1864. The old stone is barely readable, but you can make out enough to know the stone is for Andrew. The two stones are next to each other.

Father James was supposedly in the Mexican War, Army, Co E, 3rd Regiment Ohio Volunteer Infantry [3rd Regiment of Ohio Volunteers, for 12 months; June 1846 - June 1847. Colonel Samuel R. Curtis (former 2nd Lieutenant, 7th U.S. Infantry and Adj. General of Ohio).] [This is now in question. This can't be the father of Andrew Crawford. There was another James Crawford who bought land in Congress Township, 20 Sep 1827. See this [PDF file](#). James CRAWFORD is in the 1830 Federal Census for Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 128, NARA M19, Roll 142, File 0337953, digital folder 004411253, Image 00260. Was he a relative of this family? Could he have been the James Crawford who was in the Mexican War? Many times the flag holders are placed at a relative's grave when there is no stone for the actual soldier. ]

Pension Index: Andrew CRAWFORD, D 120th OH Inf. Father, James CRAWFORD, filed 1891 May 2, Application 511333, Certificate 319601, filed in Illinois.

Andrew arrived at New York, USA, on 17 July 1852 aboard the Wacousta with his parents and siblings.

Mother Janet died in 1856. Janet Kaye CRAWFORD, age 29, born 1827, died 1856.

1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne County OH, page 340: William BAXTER, age 31 PA, tailor; Harriet J?, age 23 OH; Emily E ROWN??, age 14 OH; Andrew CRAWFORD, age 13 Scotland.

Sibling: 1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 1157, Family 1145: Andrew GEORGE, age 50 OH, farmer; Maria, age 44 PA; Franklin, age 20 OH, farm laborer; Harrison, age 18 OH; Ann CRAWFORD, age 6 OH.

[Ann was still living with the GEORGE family in 1870 but she is listed as Barbary CRAWFORD, age 16 OH, hired girl.]

??Sibling: 1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 1184, Family 1172: George FLACK, age 36 OH, farmer; Elizi? [female], age 33 OH; Jenette CRAWFORD, age 10 OH; Monroe SLAUGHTER?, age 16 OH.

Father of soldier: 1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 1189, Family 1176: James CRAWFORD, age 33 Scotland, farm laborer was living with the Daniel and Susan GINDLEBERGER family.

Father: 1900 Federal Census, Burbank, Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 157, Family 162: William N. HOWER, age 49 OH, born Oct 1850, married 24 yrs, father born PA, mother born OH, dry goods merchant: Anna B, wife, age 46 OH, born Mar 1854, married 24 yrs, 5 children/5 still living; Harry C. son, age 22 OH, single, dry goods clerk; Charles W., son, age 16 OH, born Sep 1883; Mary M., daughter, age 14 OH, born Nov 1885; Nellie E., daughter, age 11 OH; born June 1889; Anna, daughter, age 7 OH, born Dec 1892 OH; James H. CRAWFORD, father in law, age 77 Scotland, widowed, born June 1822, parents born Scotland, not employed; Margaret M. YOUNG, servant, age 42 OH, single, born Sep 1857, parents born OH. [Naaman W. HOWER married Anna B. CRAWFORD, 29 June 1876, in Wayne Co OH. Married by C. A. SLATER, Minister.] [Anna Barbara HOWER died 29 Mar 1914 at Burbank, Wayne Co OH. Born 4 Mar 1854, OH. Father James Hay CRAWFORD, born Ayrshire, Scotland. Mother Janet PARKER, born Ayrshire, Scotland. Burial Burbank Cemetery.]

Ohio, Deaths and Burials: Father James H. Crawford died 11 Feb 1908 at Burbank, Wayne Co OH, age 86. Born in Scotland, 1822. Retired. Widowed.
