EBERLY, Daniel R.\* 15 Aug 1862  
Private Eberly was age 24 when he entered service. He died 11 Nov 1862 at Mansfield, Ohio. The Roll of Honor has no burial information.

Daniel EBERLY is buried at Martin's Cemetery, Section 2, in Baughman Twp, Wayne Co OH. The old Wayne County cemetery book said that the

stone had J and R as Daniel's parents. But that is no longer readable. He is next to Mary K EBERLY 1838 to 1920. Wayne County Burial Records: died 13 Nov 1862, buried Martin Mennonite Cem, Baughman Twp.

????Sister's death record: File # 26298, Mary K. EBERLY died 3 Mar 1920 at Green Twp, Wayne Co OH. She was single. Born 30 Sep 1839 in PA. Parents were Joel EBERLY and Rebecca KURTZ, born PA. Burial Martins Cemetery.

Can not find in 1850.

Could this be Daniel EVERLY????? 1860 Census, Sugar Creek Twp, Wayne County OH, page 99: Daniel RUDY, age 26 PA, farmer; Esther, age 24 PA; Barbara, age 2 PA; Jacob, age 7 months PA; **Daniel EVERLY, age 20 PA, laborer**; Harriet FROST, age 16 OH.

Ohio Obituary Index says Daniel died 13 Nov 1862 in Wayne Co OH, son of J and R, age 22. So there are some disagreements on the facts here. It does list him as being in Co D, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI.
