

## Company D, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

EGNER, Peter He was not on original list: Peter EGNER

There is no Peter EGNER/EGGNER listed at Civil War Soldiers and Sailors System in the 120th OH. Even though he applied for a pension, he may never have been a part of the 120<sup>th</sup>.

Birth: Dec 1842 OH

Death: survived the war.

Pension Card: Peter EGNER, Co D 120th OH Inf. Invalid applied for 24 Apr 1889, application 700484, filed in OH, but no certificate recorded. Is listed the same way in the Pension Index at Ancestry.

1850 Census, Crane Twp, Wyandot Co OH, Dwelling 232, Family 1659: David MAFFICE or MAFFIDE, age 32 PA, farmer; Lousa Anna, age 26 OH; Peter EGNER, age 6 OH.

1860 Census, Prairie Twp, Holmes Co OH, Dwelling 1099, Family 1122: Cyrus GRABEN?, age 22 OH, farmer; Elisabeth, age 22 OH; William W, age 1 OH; Peter EGNER, age 17 IN, farm hand.

Family Search, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Peter EGNER married Mrs. Elisabeth WEAVER on 15 Feb 1880 at Holmes Co OH.

1880 Census, Berlin Twp Dist 125, Holmes Co OH, Family 249: Peter EGNER, age 37 OH, day laborer, parents birthplaces not filled in; Elisabeth, wife, age 37 PA, parents born PA.

Not on 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Census, Holmesville Village, Prairie Twp, Holmes County Infirmary, Holmes Co OH, Dwelling 208, Family 210: Peter EDGER [sic], inmate, born Dec 1842, age 57, widowed, born OH, father born PA, mother born OH

Peter EGNER living at the Holmes County Infirmary, Millersburg Rd, in 1910 Census. He is 72, widowed, born OH. Parents born Germany.
