HELLER, John* 13 Oct 1862
Private Heller was age 33 when he entered service. He died on 30 Jan 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri.
The Roll of Honor says he is buried at St. Louis, Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery in section 65, grave 162.

Who are his parents?

John's name may have been John Henry HELLER.

1850 Census, Sugar Creek, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 357, Family 358: John HELLER, age 20 OH, no occupation is listed. He is living with a KELLER family.

Wayne County Probate Court record: John HELLER, married Eliza BEARBOWER on 12 March 1851 in Wayne County OH.

1860 Census, Sugar Creek Township, Wayne County OH page 83: John HELLER, age 30 OH, a blacksmith; Eliza, age 32, OH; Celeste, age 8 OH; Elizabeth, age 5 OH; Irvine, age 4 OH.

John did not return from the war. Died 1863.

1870 Census, Salt Creek Township page 328: Eliza HELLER, age 43 OH; Elizabeth, age 16 OH.

Wayne County Probate Court record: Marquis L. STOPHLET married Elizabeth HELLER on 10 Aug 1873 in Wayne Co OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Salt Creek, Wayne Co OH: Line 30, House 249, Family 259: Eliza HELLER widow of late John HELLER, Pvt, Co D 120 OH Inf. Post Office: Fredericksburg, Wayne Co OH. Remarks: Died while in Service.

1910 Census, Salt Creek, Wayne Co OH: Lafayette STAUFFLET, age 62 OH, parents born OH, first marriage, married 36 yrs, plumber with own shop, marked UA for Union Army; Elizabeth E. STAUFFLET, wife, age 57 OH, parents born OH, first marriage, married 36 yrs, no children; Eliza HELLER, age 82 OH, mother in law, widow, parents born OH, 3 children/1 still living.

Widow Eliza BEARBOWER HELLER. Children under 16: Celestia J, born Wayne Co OH 23 Apr 1852., Elizabeth E., born Williams Co OH 16 Oct 1853, Arvine J., born Williams Co OH, 30 Aug 1855. Post office Mt. Eaton. Soldier died of typhoid fever and chronic diarrhea. Died at General Hospital, New House of Refuge, St Louis, MO. Married 12 Mar 1851, John HELLER enrolled at Sugar Creek Twp, OH. Child Elizabeth was married to M. L. STOPHLET. Eliza died 29 July 1911 at Fredericksburg, OH. Burial in East Cem Fredericksburg, OH. Pension Card: Widow applied 7 July 1863.
