LONGANECKER, Peter 18 Aug 1862  
Private Longanecker was age 19 when he entered service. He was discharged 19 Mar 1863 at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Pension index: Peter S LONGANECKER, D 120th OH Inf. Mother of Peter S. of the 120th OVI, Nancy LONGANECKER, applied for pension in Ohio 12 May 1886, Application 339143 filed in OH, no Certificate.

Not on military eadstones list.

1850 Census, Chester, Wayne Co, OH, Dwelling 189, Family 192: John LONGNECKER, age 38 OH, farmer; Nancy, age 36 PA; Peter S, age 7 OH; Pierson LONG, age 15 OH, laborer; Chalotte HAYNE, age 16 OH.

1860 Census Chester Township, Wayne County OH: John LONGANECKER age 42 PA?, a farmer; Nancy age 40 PA; Peter S, age 17 OH; Pearson B. LONG, age 24 PA, laborer; Charlotte, age 24 PA. [Mother may have been Nancy GARBER.]

Apparently Peter came home after his discharge but died shortly after on 15 June 1863. He is buried in Chester Township, Eight Square Mennonite Cemetery.

1870 Ohio Agriculture Census, Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH, dated Sep 1870, line 11: John LONGANECKER.

John and Nancy LONGACRE had a daughter age 15 in the 1880 census in Chester Twp
