LOOP, Wilson S. 7 Aug 1862 Wilson Shannon LOOP

Private Loop was age 20 when he entered service. He was discharged on 13 April 1863 at Smith's plantation, Louisiana on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

Civil War Draft Registrations Records, 1863-1865: Wooster Twp, Wayne Co OH, dated June 1863: Shannon LOUP, age 23, born OH, single, laborer, does not list previous service.

Official roster of the soldiers of the state of Ohio in the War of the Rebellion, 1861-1866, Vol X: Company G 189th OVI, Wilson S. LOOP entered service on 12 Oct 1864, age 24, for one year of service. He had been transferred from Co H 102 OVI to the 189th on 12 July 1865. He was mustered out of the 189th with his company on 28 Sep 1865.

Obituary

"Died. In Wooster, on Tuesday evening, March 26, 1872, of pulmonary consumption, Shannon Loop, aged 32 years.

To many it is hard to believe that Shannon is dead and in his grave. None had more or warmer personal friends. The burial of his body in the Wooster Cemetery on Thursday afternoon was the largest funeral procession witnessed for months in the city, in honor of the memory of the dead, and when the body was lowered into its grave tears welled up into the eyes of many unused to weep. He sleeps his last sleep - a loving son, a kind brother and affectionate friend."
