McDOUGAL, Neal 9 Sept 1863

Private McDougal was age 35 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. E 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co D, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 9 May 1866.

Kenora was his previous residence.]. No widow's pension. Kenora is in Ontario, Canada.

Family Search, Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: Neal McDOUGAL died, age 87, at Jefferson Twp, Montgomery Co, OH, on 31 Jan 1915. Born 1828 in Scotland. Single. Trapper. Parents names not known. Burial at Nat'l Mil. Home. Dayton National Cem. Pvt Infantry but regiment not listed.

Dayton National Military Home:

Admitted to Dayton National Military Home on 27 Feb 1913. He was age 85, born in Scotland. 5 ft, 5 inches tall. Fair complexion. Blue eyes. Gray hair. Could not read and write. Protestant. Trapper. Residence subsequent to discharge, Kenora, Canada. Single. "None" written in for nearest relative. He had enlisted in Co D 48th OH Inf, 9 Sept 1863 at Mansfield OH. [Actually he was transferred to the 48th OH Inf.] Problems at admission: Trouble with vision and hearing. Heart trouble. Old fracture of left clavicle. Old fracture of left hip with 2.5 inches of shortening. Deformity in right leg at ankle. Died 31 Jan 1915 of acute bronchitis, arteriosclerosis and senility. Had no relatives or friends listed.
