Private McMannis was age 22 when he entered service. He was discharged 10 Dec 1863 at Columbus, Ohio on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

[Hardesty's Historical and Geographical Encyclopedia](#). [Wayne County version] page 485 Plain Twp section Elmer McMannis was nearly sixteen months a soldier in Company D, 120th O.V.I. He enlisted at Wooster, August 22, 1862, and was mustered into service at Mansfield, Richland county, October 28th, following. The regiment went down to become a part of Sherman's army for the movement on Vicksburg, and was assigned to the 2d brigade, 2d division, 13th army corps. In its earliest battles Mr. McMannis participated, fighting at Chickasaw Bayou, Arkansas Post, the battles of the regiment in the siege of Vicksburg, and, after the fall of the city, taking part in the engagement at Jackson, which was his last battle. He was injured at Arkansas Post, while assisting in loading government transports, receiving a strain which resulted in hernia. This grew worse and to it were added chronic diarrhea, fever and ague, and general debility, which exhibited itself in the dangerous form. For five months later he was unfit for field service. He was detailed to take care of the adjutant's horse, and as an extra man for duty at headquarters. He then was sent home to Ohio on furlough, and when ordered to Columbus, reported there, was for a time treated for his complication of diseases, and then discharged, his papers bearing date December 10, 1863. He is a member of Given Post, No 133, G.A.R., at Wooster, but is a farmer of Plain township, with postoffice address at Plain. He is the son of Charles and Nancy (Jones) McMannis, and was born in Wayne county, January 20, 1840. In this county was born, August 6, 1843, Lehanna, daughter of John A. and Sarah (Rouch) Lawrence. She became the wife of Mr. McMannis October 4, 1864, and they have three children, Loretta Jane, Nora Dell, and Harry Sherman. Mr. McMannis had two brothers, William Riley and James Neal, who were soldiers, enlisting in Fulton county, and his wife had three brothers, [John \[Company A 120th OVI\]](#), Henry, and Isaiah Lawrence, in the service, who went from Wayne county.

McMANNIS, age 4 OH; N D McMANNIS [female], age one OH, E S McMANNIS, [female] age 15 OH, house keeper; O S McMANNIS [male], age 17 OH, works on farm; Neal JOLLIFF, age 9 OH.

Wayne County Grave Registrations book: Elmer McMannis was born 20 Jan 1840 in PA. He died 1 Oct 1915 in Wooster. His address was Wooster. He is buried in Warner Cemetery in Wooster Township. (Lot 27, Block 1, grave 2.) Next of kin listed was Harry McAnaney of Wooster. Elmer was listed in the roster as Elmore.
