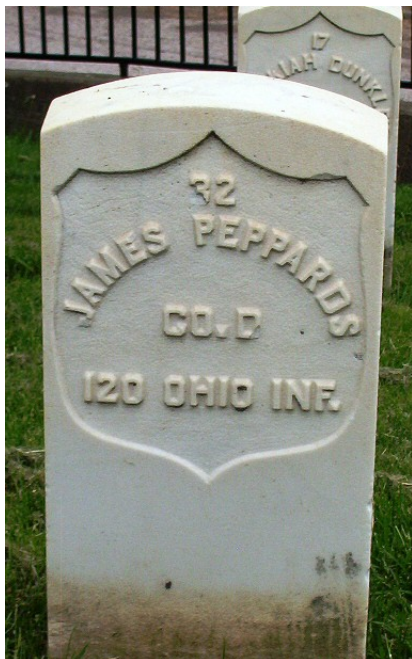

PEPPARD, James\* 18 Aug 1862  
Private Peppard was age 39 when he entered service. He died 9 Oct 1863 at Keokuk, Iowa.  
The Roll of Honor says he is buried at Keokuk, Iowa.

Death: 9 Oct 1863, Keokuk, Lee Co, IA  
Cemetery: Keokuk National Cemetery, Lee Co IA, stone has Peppards, James, D 120 OHIO INF, Plot: 32. At Nationwide Gravesite Locator: d. 10/09/1863, PVT, Section C, Site 32 and/or Fredericksburg East Cem, Wayne Co OH There is a stone for Civil War soldier Peppard, James, no date given, at Fredericksburg, East cemetery, Wayne county, OH.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: James PIPPARDS, Private, Co D 120th OH Inf, died 9 Oct 1863 at General Hospital Keokuk, IA. Cause: jaundice.

Have not found on Burial Registers, Military Posts and National Cemeteries, 1862-1960.

National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962: James PEPPARDS, name also borne as James PEPPARD. Pvt. Co D, 120 OH Inf. Died 8 Oct 1863. Buried at Keokuk, IA National Cemetery, Grave 32.

Pension Index: James PEPPARDS, Co D 120 OH Inf. Widow, Mary J. PEPPARDS, applied 2 Nov 1863, Application 37434, Certificate 21774. Minor application made 26 June 1869, Application 173713, Certificate 136759.

Some family information from Kathryn Davis, 2nd great granddaughter of James Peppard, through James' daughter Hiley Malinda Peppard Davis. His wife, and several of his children moved to Kansas and Colorado after the war with two of James's brothers. The brothers were: Samuel G and Thomas G Peppard. The brothers served in the 2nd Colorado Calvary and 17th Kansas Infantry respectively. The brothers, and his daughter Hiley(my great grandmother) are all buried in Pleasant View Cemetery in Oskaloosa, Kansas. His wife remarried. Her third husband was: Jonathan Lawrence; they married in 1892 in Ohio(Lawrence is the family name on her headstone). She later moved to Oskaloosa and is also buried in [Pleasant View Cemetery](#).  
Note: Mary J. died Dec 1910.]

Wayne county OH probate court records: James Peppard married Mary Jane BELL, 3 Feb 1847.

1850 Census, Prairie Twp, Holmes Co OH: James PEPPERD, age 26 OH, labourer; Mary J, age 18 OH; Martha, age 2 OH; H. M. [female], age 2 months. [Living near Frances PEPPERD, age 30 OH and family.]

1860 census, Fredericksburg, Salt Creek twp. Wayne county OH: James PEPPARD, age 36 OH, plasterer; and Mary J., age 31 OH; Martha E., age 12 [Martha Ellen]; Hira Malinda, age 11 OH [ Hiley Melinda born in Holmes county, according to Family Search] , Rosy, age 9 OH; Jerusia, age 7 OH[female] [Jerusia Carrie], Garret, age 4 OH, and Amanda, age 4 months OH [Amanda Jane].

1Martha Ellen [1848] Martha Ellen was in Elkart IN living with Simon BARINGER.1868 [Family Search, Indiana, Marriages, 1811-1959: Martha PEPPARD married Oliver FOSS on 8 Apr 1869 at Elkhart Co IN.]

2Hiley Melinda [1849] married George W. DAVIS

3Wiley 22 or 4 Mar 1851 .....Was he William?

4Rosey 12 Feb 1853 Rosa was living with Henry SHAW in Elkart IN.1868 [Family Search, Indiana, Marriages, 1811-1959: Rosa PEPPARD married John A. LONZO on 30 Sep 1869 at Elkhart Co, IN.]

5Jerusha 22 Mar 1855 Jerusha was with her uncle Isaac PEPPARD in Oscalusa KS.1868

6Garrett, 10 Jan 1857, married Viola [Fannie Margaret MOLTER]. [Family Search, Ohio, Marriages, 1800-1958: Garrett PEPPARD married Fannie MOULTER on 26 Sep 1878 at Wayne Co OH.]

Family Search, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Mary Jane PEPPARD married David FOSS on 6 Oct 1867 at Wayne Co OH.

Widow remarried and children: 1870 Census, Wooster Ward 3, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 197, Family 184: David FOSS, age 52 PA, brush maker; Mary J, age 40 OH; Garrett, age 14 OH; Amanda, age 9 OH; James, age 7 OH.

Widow remarried: 1880 Census, North Walnut St, Wooster, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 115, Family 134: David FOSS, age 62 PA, brush maker, parents born PA; Mary J, wife, age 52 OH, parents born OH. [David FOSS died at the home of his daughter, Mary WERT, on 12 Mar 1891 at Ohio City, Liberty Twp, Van Wert Co OH.]

Widow, Family Search, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Mary J. FOSS married Jonathan LAWRENCE on 12 Jan 1892 at Wayne Co OH. [pension papers below]

Brother Thomas?, 1900 Census, Oskaloosa, Jefferson Co KS, Thomas PEPPARD, age 64 OH, widowed, born Feb 1836, father born OH, mother born PA, day laborer; Madge, daughter, age 27 KS, born Nov 1872, father born OH, mother born IA; Roy, son, age 18 KS, single, born June 1881, father born OH, mother born IA day laborer; Benjamin, son, age 16 KS, single, born Sept 1883, day laborer, father born OH, mother born IA; Gilmore, son, single, age 21 KS, born Apr 1879, farm laborer, father born OH, mother born IA.

Mary J. was restored to the pension roll in Fillmore Co NE in 1901

Mary died at Hiley's home in Oskaloosa, KS 8 Dec 1910, but she isn't in the 1910 census.

Son James, 1900 Census, Wooster Ward 3, Wayne Co OH, 36 Columbus Ave, Dwelling 230, Family 252: James PEPPARD, age 37 OH, born Nov 1862, married 15 yrs, parents born OH, day laborer; Elizabeth, wife, age 36 OH, born Aug 1863, married 15 yrs, 3 children/3 still living, parents born OH; Harold, son, age 14 OH, born June 1885; Ralph, son, age 9, born Nov 1890; Ethel, daughter, age 7 OH, born Nov 1892. [Harrold B. PEPPARD's marriage record lists his mother as Elizabeth MILLER.]

Son James, 1910 Census, Wooster Ward 1, Wayne Co OH, 24 East Henry St, Dwelling 202, Family 227: James B. PEPPARD, age 47 OH, first marriage, married 25 yrs, parents born OH, brush maker; Elizabeth, wife, age 45? OH, first marriage, married 25 yrs, parents born OH; Ralph R, son, age 19 OH, single, brush maker; Ethel M, daughter, age 17 OH, single, telephone operator.

Son James, Family Search, Ohio, Deaths, 1908-1953: James C. PEPPARD, died 15 Dec 1949, age 87, in Altman Hospital, Canton, Stark co OH. Born 3 Nov 1862 at Frederickburg [sic] OH. Widowed. Retired foreman in steel company. Address 1109 MaGee Ct. SE, Canton OH. Father James PEPPARD. Mother's maiden name unknown. Informant Mrs. J. C. Clark. James fell and fractured his neck and left femur, not at work, on 10 Dec 1949. Burial at West Brookfield Cem, Massillon, OH.

Son Garret, 1880 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 90, Family 91: Garret PEPPER, age 24 OH, laborer, parents born OH; Viola, wife, age 20 OH, parents born PA; Amanda E, daughter, age 8 months, born Sep 1879 OH. [Family Search, Michigan, Death Certificates, 1921-1952: Amanda Elizabeth STRANGE died 8 Jan 1841 at Detroit, Wayne Co MI, age 61. Married. Born 27 Sep 1879 at Wooster, OH. Father Garret PEPPARD. Mother Fannie Margaret MOLTER.]

Son Garret, 1900 Census, Wooster Ward 3, Wayne Co OH, 61 West Liberty St, Dwelling 73, Family 79: Garrett PEPPERS, boarder, age 45 OH, born Jan 1855, single, parents born OH. Garrett is boarding in the home of Charles and Jessie ZARING.

Son Garret, 1910 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 117, Family 120: James G. SHELLY, age 28 OH, first marriage, married 5 yrs, parents born OH, farmer, general farm; Ida M, wife, age 22 OH, first marriage, married 5 yrs, one child/one still living, parents born Germany; James L, son, age one yr 2 months OH; Garret PEPPARD, hired man, age 54 OH, widowed, parents born OH, laborer.

Daughter, Amanda: Family Search, Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Amanda J. PEPPARD married Cornelius H. FISHER on 25 Jun 1878 at Wayne Co OH, by Rev. G. A. Hughes.

Daughter Amanda: 1880 Census, Wooster, Wayne Co OH, North Walnut St, Dwelling 115, Family 136: Howard C. FISHER, age 33 OH, agent for whip factory, parents birth places not filled in; Amanda, wife, age 20 OH, father born OH, mother born PA; Raymond, son, age one OH.

Grandchildren, Ohio Obituary Index: Cornelius FISHER died 25 Oct 1899 at Wayne Co OH. Guardianship 5 children. I have found Raymond E.-1879, Lucy C.-1883, E. Edwin-1893, Darl E.[female]-1888, Ethel-1892, and Harvey B.-1881, children of Amanda PEPPARD and Cornelius FISHER.

Grandson, Raymond: 1900 Census, Wooster, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 223, Family 224: Raymond D. FISHER, boarder, age 21 OH, single, born May 1879, farm laborer, parents born OH. [Note: Raymond E. FISHER whose mother was Amanda PEPPARD, died 13 Feb 1925 at Wooster, wife Grace. He was buried at Wooster Cemetery.]

Also spelled PEPPARDS. Post office address Fredericksburg, OH. Soldier died 9 Oct 1863 at 5th street hospital, 4th Ward, Keokuk, IA, from jaundice and chronic diarrhea. Married 3 Feb 1847. James enrolled at Salt Creek Twp. Remarriage: Mrs. Mary Jane PEPPARD married Mr. David FOSS on 6 Oct 1867. At that time, the children had turned these ages on these dates: Garret, 13 yrs on 9 Jan 1869; Amanda, 9 yrs on 28 Feb 1869; James, 5 yrs on 2 Nov 1868. Rosey was 17 on 10 Mar 1869. Jerusha was age 15 on 8 Feb 1869. Pension Card: James PEPPARDS, Co D 120th OH Inf., widow applied 2 Nov 1863. A minor pension was also applied for.

2 Dec 1868, Mary Jane FOSS again gave the birth dates of her children saying that there must have been a misunderstanding: Martha Ellen, 10 Feb 1848; Hiley, 4 Mar 1851; Rosey, 12 Feb 1853; Jerusha 22 Mar 1855; Garret 10 Jan 1857; Amanda 29 Feb 1860; James 3 Nov 1862. The 3 youngest were in her custody.

The rest were with relatives. Martha Ellen was in Elkart IN living with Simon BARINGER. Hiley was married to George DAVIS and living in Oskaloosa KS. Rosa was living with Henry SHAW in Elkart IN. Jerusha was with her uncle Isaac PEPPARD in Oskaloosa KS.

David FOSS died at the home of his daughter, Mary WERT, on 12 Mar 1891 at Ohio City, Liberty Twp, Van Wert Co OH.

Mary Jane married Jonathan LAWRENCE in Wayne Co OH on 12 Jan 1892. Jonathan, born VT, died 10 Jan 1896 at Congress, Wayne Co OH. She was restored to the pension roll in Fillmore Co NE in 1901. Daughter C. J. VEDERHOLD and her husband Joseph VEDERHOLD testified that she had not remarried after LAWRENCE died.

Mary owned land in Congress, Wayne Co OH.

When Mary died Mrs. Hiley M. DAVIS lived at R.F.D. 3 in Oskaloosa, KS. Mary died 8 Dec 1910 at Hiley's home 1.5 miles east of Oskaloosa. She was buried at Pleasant ???? Cemetery in Oskaloosa. Hiley and daughter Eva DAVIS took care of Mary. [Mary died Dec 1910, Jefferson Co KS, born 7 Apr 1829]
