PHILLIPS, Isaiah\* 18 Aug 1862

Private Phillips was age 18 when he entered service. He died 2 Mar 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi in section C, grave 39. [Plot: C 2312]
