

Company D, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

PINKERTON, Jacob 21 Aug 1862

Private Pinkerton was age 25 when he entered service. He was transferred to 36th Co., 1st Battalion, Veteran Reserve Corps on 27 Apr 1864; thence to Col E, 11th Regiment Veteran Reserve Corps [date not given]; mustered out 8 July 1865 at Readville, Massachusetts.
