THOMPSON, John E. * 20 Aug 1862

Musician John Thompson was age 36 when he entered service. He died on 3 Mar 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor says he is buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi. [Not listed at interment.com]

Pension Index: John E. THOMPSON of Co D 120th OH Inf, pension applied for in 1863 in OH. Pension Card: Widow, Elizabeth A. THOMPSON, applied 17 Apr 1863, Application 18685, Certificate 7598. Minor also applied for and is on a separate pension card: Minor application by W. BARTON, filed 1 Dec 1869, Application 182043, Certificate 137853, no state given. [The widow's pension was consolidated with the minor pension 137853; so I suppose that is why it wasn't at fold3.com with the other widows' pensions.]
