

## Company D, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

WAGNOR, Michael 19 Aug 1862

Private Wagner was age 23 when he entered service. He was discharged 16 Feb 1863 at Young's Point, Louisiana on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

1860 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County OH, page 306: Fredk W BARNHART, age 34 PA, master miller; Clarissa, age 26 OH; Emma, age 4 OH; William, age 2 OH; R..atthor [female] age 3 months OH; Michael WAGGONER, age 21 France, ?Beer Runner; David FLACK, age 24 OH, mash hand; Robert LANDES, age 28 OH, teamster; William HUTCHISON, age 21 PA, apprentice miller; John FINKLE, age 26 PA, miller; Mary, age 26 PA.

Wayne county OH probate: Michael WAGNER married Mary HAWK, 15 Feb 1866

1870 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County OH, page 54: Michael WAGONER, age 30 France, a cooper; Mary, age 33 OH; Margaret, age 2 OH.

1880 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 68: Michael WAGNER, age 41 France, laborer, parents born France; Mary M, wife, age 43 OH, parents born PA; Nettie M, daughter age 11 OH; Sarah E, daughter, age 9 OH; Charles J, son, age 5 OH; Barbara, daughter, age 3 OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH: Line 14, House 65, Family 66: Michel WAGONER, Pvt, Co D 120 OH Inf. Post Office: Cedar Valley, OH. Disability at Young Point, ruptures.

1900 Census, Series T623 Roll 1331, Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 63: Michel WAGNER, age 61 Germany, born Sep 1838, married 44 yrs, parents born Germany; emigrated 1858, lived in US 42 yrs, naturalized, farm laborer; Mary M, wife, age 63 OH, born Mar 1837, married 44 yrs, 6 children/4 still living, parents born PA; E. Ella, daughter, age 29 OH, single; Charley J, son, age 25 OH, single, born Jan 1875.

1910 Census, Chester Twp, East precinct, Wayne County, OH, page 66: Michael Wagner, age 71 Germany, widowed, parents born in Germany, spoke German, has own income, says he came to US in 1858 and became a citizen; Ellen S, daughter, age 39 OH, single, parents born Germany; Charles J, son, age 35 OH, single, bridge carpenter? steam railroad, parents born Germany. [Column 30 indicates UA for military service for Michael.]

There is a Civil War soldier Wagner, Michael 1838-1912 buried at Overton Church of God, Chester township, Wayne county OH.

There is an obituary in the Wayne County Democrat, 31 Dec 1912, page 4. [died 28 Dec 1912] It states that Michale Wagner had lived near Overton for over 50 years. He had 2 daughters, Mrs. Nettie Brinkerhoff and Miss Ella Wagner and an only son Charles still living. He also had 7 grandchildren living. He was buried at Bethel in Overton. No mention of military service in the obituary.

Parents and siblings of Michael Wagner:

1900 Orrville, Green Twp, Wayne County OH, page 210: Barbary WAGNER, age 86 France, an invalid and a widow, born Mar 1814, 7 children/4 still living, parents born France. According to researchers at World Connect, this is the mother of Michael Wagner. His father, Jacob, died in France. Michael and several siblings came to the US. [Jacob, John, Christian, and Katherine were the siblings who came. Jacob, who may have been living in Green Twp, Wayne County OH, page 56, in 1860 with the Jonathan and Annie YODER family, eventually went to TN. John lived in Orrville, Wayne County OH, married to Elizabeth HILTY. Christian eventually went to Utah. Katherine married Simon BRENIZER of Smithville and eventually went to South Dakota.]

Family Search Death Record in Ohio: File #69270, Michael WAGNOR died 28 Dec 1912 at Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH. Widowed. Retired. Born 24 Sep 1838 at Alsace Lorain, France. Father WAGNOR. Mother Barbara EICKER or EICHER. Burial at Overton Cemetery. Informant Miss Ella WAGNER of Burbank OH.

Brother's Family Search Death Record in Ohio: File #65110, John WAGNER died 12 Oct 1916 at East Union Twp, Wayne Co OH. Married. Farmer. Born 9 Mar 1847 at Switzerland. Father John WAGNER, born Switzerland. Mother Barbara EICHER born Switzerland. Burial Crown Hill. Informant Mrs. John WAGNER of Orrville OH.
