

## Company D, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

WEDDLE, Jesse\* 8 Aug 1862 Jesse W.  
Private Weddle was age 25 when he entered service. He died 16 July 1863 at Columbus, Ohio. The Roll of Honor says his remains were sent home.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: John W. WEDDELL or WEDDELE, Private, Co D 120th OH Inf, died 16 July 1863 at Seminary General Hospital Columbus, OH. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

???1850 Census, Vermillion, Ashland Co OH, Dwelling 279, Family 287: James WEDDLE, age 54 PA, farmer; Biah, [female], age 42 PA; Jesse, age 18 PA, farmer; Mary, age 11 OH.

In the 1860 census Jesse Weddle is age 23 [PA], an journeyman cabinetmaker, living in Wooster, Wayne county OH with the William Spear family.

1860 Census, Wooster, Wayne County OH, Dwelling 414, Family 413 : William SPEAR, age 56 PA, master cabinet maker; Malinda, age 46 OH ; Wesley W. age 24 OH, cabinet maker [also soldier this regiment];

Caroline, age 22 OH ; Olive, age 15 OH. Also living there were Jesse WIDDLE, age 23 PA, journeyman cabinet maker; George WYMER, age 26 Germany, journeyman cabinet maker; John MARKS, age 17 OH, apprentice cabinet maker; John BOYDSTON, age 17 OH, apprentice cabinet maker; Alfred WALLICH, age 18 OH, apprentice cabinet maker.
