

## Company D, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

This stone at Jefferson Barracks had Illinois written on it instead of OH. But the US Department of Military Affairs lists that grave as Hiram B Wisner. Death date matches the one for the soldier in the 120th OH Inf. Civil War Soldiers and Sailors does not list a soldier by that name in Illinois. [There is no WISNER](#) in Co D 120th IL.

WISNER, Hiram B.\* 21 Aug 1862

Private Wisner was age 19 when he entered service. He died 4 July 1863 at St. Louis, Missouri. The Roll of Honor says Hiram WISNER is buried at St. Louis,

Missouri in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Hiram B. WISNER, Private, Co D 120th OH Inf, died 4 July 1863 at General Hospital Jefferson Barracks MO. Cause: chronic diarrhoea.

National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962: Hiram B. WISNER, Pvt, Co D 120 IL Inf, died 4 July 1863, Grave 7110, Originally buried at Jefferson Barracks, MO.

Pension index: Hiram B. WISNER, Co D 120 Ohio Inf. Father, John WISNER, applied for pension 9 Dec 1880, Application 279257, no Certificate; and sister, Hester A. WISNER, applied 10 June 1893, Application 578390, no Certificate, filed in OH.

1850 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 273, Family 274: John WISNER, age 60 PA, farmer; Mary, age 46 PA; Caroline HAMOIKER, age 24 PA; Elmyra S., HAMOIKER, age 20 OH; Matilda WISNER, age 16 OH; Jane WISNER, age 16 OH; Hiram B., age 7 OH; Esther Ann WISNER, age 4 OH; William, age 22 OH, carpenter.

1860 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 18: John WISNER [hard to read], age 70 PA, a farmer; Mary, age 56 PA; Jane, age 19 OH; Hiram WISNER, age 17 OH; Hester, age 13 OH.

[Note: Father: Probate records at Wayne county OH: John Wisner married Mary HAMICKER on 25 Nov 1832.]

Father, 1870 Census, East Union, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 129, Family 127:L John WISNER, age 80 PA, retired carpenter; Mary, age 66 PA; Hester, age 23 PA.

Father, 1880 Census Apple Creek, Wayne County, OH, page 172: John WISNER, age 90 PA, retired carpenter, father born NJ, mother born Ireland; Hester Ann WISNER, daughter, single, age 33 OH, parents born OH; Mary SPENCER, "other", age 60 OH, domestic servant, parents born PA.

Sister's Death Record in Ohio: File #45629, [Hester Ann WISNER](#) died 3 June 1920 at Apple Creek, East Union Twp, Wayne Co OH. Single. House keeper. Born 17 Aug 1846 at OH. Father John WISNER born PA. Mother Mary HORNER. Burial Apple Creek, OH.
