ANDERSON, Samuel G. 20 Aug 1862 Alternate name Samuel J. Anderson
 Corporal Anderson was age 25 when he entered service. He was appointed 1 June 1863; transferred to Co. H 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Ohio, County Marriages: Samuel J. ANDERSON married Clarinda J. KISTLER on 28 Jul 1870 at Hancock Co, OH.

Ohio, Deaths and Burials: S. J. ANDERSON died at Jackson Twp, Wood Co OH on 5 Feb 1908. Age 70. Farmer. Born abt 1838. White. Married.

Wife, Ohio, Deaths: Clarinda Jane ANDERSON died 17 Feb 1931 at Hoytville Jackson Twp, Wood Co OH. Age 80y 2m. Widow. Born 18 Dec 1850 at Findlay OH. Father Benjamin KISTLER born Picqua OH. Mother Sara SEARFOSS, born Picqua, OH. Spouse Samuel J. ANDERSON. Informant Grover ANDERSON of Hoytville OH. Burial place not given.

This is a different Samuel Anderson.

So who is this Samuel Anderson buried in Wooster Cemetery?

This Samuel Anderson had to have been in another regiment, not the 120th OVI. There is a stone in Wooster Cemetery with his name and the 120th OVI inscription, but this Samuel Anderson did not die until 1918 and his wife's name was Emma. This Samuel may have been the Private in the 186th and Co A, 188th OH. He also had the middle initial G. The 188th Ohio mustered in March 4, 1865 and mustered out at Nashville, Tenn., September 21, 1865. Perhaps the mistake was made when the record was looked up in preparation for his military stone.

There is a Civil War pension index file for Samuel G. Anderson Co A 188th OH Inf. Filed 8 Aug 1918. He must have died the following September.

1900 Census Plain Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 44: Samuel ANDERSON, age 60 OH, born Nov 1839, married 21 yrs, farm laborer, parents born PA; Emma, wife, age 40 OH, born Oct 1859, married 21 yrs, 4 children/4 still living, parents born PA; Mary, daughter, age 17 OH, born Sep 1882, single, parents born OH.

1910 Census, 226 North Grant St, Wooster, Wayne County, OH, Dwelling 5, Family 6: Samuel ANDERSON, age 73 OH, first marriage, married 32 yrs, no occupation, father born PA, mother born OH, not marked for military service; Emma, wife, age 51 OH, first marriage, married 32 yrs, 4 children/4 still living, father born PA, mother born OH. [Living in same dwelling are Jerome and Julia CLARK and their two children Ruth and Paul. Are they related to Samuel and Emma?]
