BROWN, Lewis* 15 Aug 1862

Private Lewis Brown was age 23 when he entered service.

He died 17 Mar 1863 at Memphis, Tennessee. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Memphis, Tennessee in the Mississippi River Cemetery. [not listed] Died on hospital boat City of Memphis. Born 1839. [Wayne Co OH Grave Registration Cards]

Marriage: Miranda J. HUBBARD on 10 [20] Aug 1862 at Wooster, Wayne Co OH

Marinda J., wife of Lewis Brown, died ?15 Mar 1863, 17 yrs, 7? m, 16 ds.

Death: 17 Mar 1863 at Memphis, Tennessee Co E 120th OVI, Died on hospital boat "City of Memphis" 17 Mar 1862, age 24 y, 4?m, 9d

Cemetery: Apple Creek #1 Cemetery, Apple Creek, Wayne Co OH: Apple Creek Presbyterian Cemetery

Stone has Co E, flag holder has Co H.

Relationship: Brother of Enos BROWN of Co E 120th.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1863: Lewis BROWN, Private, Co E 120th OH Inf, 17 Mar 1863, on floating Hospital "City of Memphis", cause: typhoid fever.

Pension Card: Lewis BROWN Co E 120th OH Inf. Minor pension, guardian L. RETTER?, applied for 20 Nov 1863, Application 39087, Certificate 35239.

1850 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 213: Noah BROWN, age 43 PA, farmer; Ann, age 43 PA; Delila, age 20 OH; Simon, age 18 OH; Enos, age 16 OH [see soldier above]; Reason, age 14 OH; Lewis, age 12 OH; Emeline, age 2 OH. [Ohio, County Marriages: Noah BROWN married Anna STINGER on 16 July 1829 in Wayne Co OH.]

1860 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 24, Dwelling 339, Family 352: Noah BROWN, age 54 PA, farmer; Ann, age 53 PA; Reason, age 24 OH; Lewis, age 21 OH; Emeline, age 13 OH; John, age 8 OH; Amos, age 26 OH; Sarah, age 16 OH.

Ohio Marriages: Lewis BROWN married Meranda [Miranda] J. HUBBARD on 20 Aug 1862 at Wooster, Wayne Co OH.

1870 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 242, Family 238: Noah BROWN, age 63 PA, farmer; Ann, age 63 PA; John, age 16 OH; Emeline LANDIS, age 22 OH. [Note: Simon BROWN is living next door.]

Pension files at fold3.com:

Lewis Brown died on US Hospital Boat "City of Memphis" near Memphis TN on 17 Mar 1863 from diarrhea. Jessie A BROWN, minor child [female] of Lewis BROWN, Co E 120th OH Vols. Post office Apple Creek, Wayne Co OH.

Marinda Jane BROWN died 13/15/16 Mar 1863 at Wayne Co OH. Jessie B. Brown was born 6 Mar 1863. Henry H HUBBARD and Alice HUBBARD were present at the birth of Jessie A Brown, only child of Lewis and Marinda Brown. Jessie was born at the Hubbard home in East Union, Wayne Co OH. The attending doctor was Alexander Adams.

Marinda Jane HUBBARD and Lewis BROWN were married 20 Aug 1862.

Levi REITER, of Post Office Apple Creek, East Union Twp, Wayne Co OH, was guardian of the minor child of Lewis Brown, Jessie A. Brown.

Lewis and Marinda married 20 Aug 1862 in Wayne Co OH by Andrew Virtue, Minister of Gospel.

Affidavit on 30 July 1864 at Parish of Pointe Coupée, by Enos BROWN, Co E 120th OVI: "Lewis Brown was taken sick with said disease [chronic diarrhoea] on or about the 1st day of March 1863, at, or near Youngs Point La., and continued sick with the same until the day of his death which occurred on or about said 17th day of March 1863 on board U. S. Hospital Steamer 'City of Memphis' near Memphis Tenn. That he was present when said Lewis Brown died and saw him interred.

Samuel GEITGEY was another guardian of Jessie A. BROWN. Certificate 35239.
