BURNS, Thomas S.* 20 Feb 1864

Private Thomas S. Burns was age 18 when he entered service. He died 22 June 1864 at Baton Rouge, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

1850 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 146, Family 148: William H?, BURNS, age 31 PA; Mary J, age 26 OH, marked insane; Thomas S, age 4 OH; Salena, age 2 OH; Franklin, age 6 months OH. [Note: Franklin died in 1853; buried at Congress Cem, Wayne Co OH] [Ohio Marriages: William W. BARNES [sic] married Mary Jane HOWEY, 22 Apr 1845, Wayne Co OH.]

1860 Census, Canaan Twp, Wayne County OH, page 238: Samson NOFTZGER, age 32 OH, farmer; Elizabeth, age 29 OH; Willia M, age 1 OH; Thomas BURN, age 14 OH.

sibling Elizabeth BURNS, daughter of Wm and Mary Jane, was adopted by D and E BEAL. She died 5 Mar 1861 at age 4 yrs, 8 m, 26 dys. Buried at Congress Cemetery. Wayne Co OH Information at [Find a Grave](#).

[Family Search: His parents were William H and Mary Jane (HOWEY) BURNS. Thomas Sloan BURNS was born in 1846 in Wayne County OH. His siblings were Isabella, Salena and Franklin. His father died in 1857 and I believe that his mother was living with another family in Congress Twp in 1860. William and Mary are buried at Congress Cemetery, Wayne Co OH. Mary died 1862.]
