

## Company E, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry

CAMPBELL, John P.\* 15 Aug 1862          John Parker CAMPBELL  
Private Campbell was age 18 when he entered service. He was killed 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, Louisiana. **No burial information is given in the Roll of Honor.**

Father: Parker E. CAMPBELL

Mother: Malinda HEPLER [HEEFER]

Birth: 1844 [Congress, Wayne Co OH [contributed by Sandy Rice]

Marriage: Did not marry.

Death: 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point, on the Red River, LA

Cemetery: His actual burial place may be lost, but his name is on a stone at Congress Cemetery, Wayne Co OH where his parents are buried. See [Find a Grave](#) that stone may be a cenotaph.

**Relationship: [Contributed by Sandy Rice] John's brother, Daniel, married Elmira Elizabeth FRANCE, daughter of Isaac FRANCE, Co E, 120<sup>th</sup> OVI.**

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1863: John Parker Campbell, Co E 120th OH Inf, died 3 May 1864, at Regimental Hospital, cause: gun shot wound. **[There were a number of men who were at Snaggy Point and the record says that they died at Regimental Hospital. But this is apparently just where the death was recorded, because they actually died at Snaggy Point and were probably buried there or their bodies were lost. This would be why there is not official record of where they were buried.]**

1850 Census, Congress, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 311, Family 320: Parker E. CAMPBELL, age 35 OH, farmer; Malinda, age 28 OH; **John P**, age 5 OH; Daniel, age 3 OH; Martha J, age 2 OH. [Note: Parker D Campbell married Melinda HEEFER on 17 Mar 1842, Wayne Co OH.]

1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne County, OH, Dwelling 1267, Family 1255 : Parker D CAMPBELL, age 46 PA, farmer; Melinda, age 36 PA; **John P**, age 16 PA, farm labor; Daniel, age 14 OH; Martha J, age 11 OH; Wm H, age 8 OH; Frank, age 4 OH; Lena B, age 2 OH; Phebe A COOK, age 20 PA. [Frank's 1928 death record lists mother as Malinda HELFER.]
