CASE, Matthew W. 23 Sept 1862

Private Matthew Case was age 19 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Father: Onesimus CASE

Mother: Sarah WILLIAMS

Birth: Dec 1842 [1843] OH

Marriage: Helen ASHELMAN, 17 Oct 1867, Fulton Co IN

Death: 14 June 1921, Alta Vista, KS

Pension Index: Matthew W CASE, H 114th, E 120th, and F 48th OH Inf. Invalid filed in Kansas in 1882 March 25, Application 444152, Certificate 311759, filed in KS. Widow Helen Case applied for pension in Kansas on 2 July 1921, Application 1176228, Certificate 903728, filed in KS. Pension Card: Matthew died 14 June 1921 at Alta Vista, KS.

1850 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling ??6, Family 406:

Augustus CASE [Note: Revolutionary War soldier], age 91 NJ,

occupation none; Sarah, age 37 OH; Augustus, age 17 OH, farmer; Susanna, age 16? OH; Wesley, age 11 OH; Albert, age 9 OH; Matthew, age 7 OH; Onesimus, age 5 OH; Mary E, age 2 OH.

1860 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 277: Sarah CASE, widow, age 43 PA; Wesley, age 21, farmer; Albert, age 19 OH; Mathias or Mathew age 17 OH; Onesimus, age 15 OH; Mary Eliza, age 12 OH.

[Family Search: Matthew's father was Onesimus CASE. His mother was Sarah [WILLIAMS] CASE. Father Onesimus died 1849. Mother Sarah died 1863?]]

Indiana Marriages: Matthew W. CASE married Helen ASHELMAN/ASHLEYMAN, 17 Oct 1867, Fulton Co IN.

[In 1860, Ellen ASHELMAN, age 11 OH, was listed with Samuel and Lydia ASHELMAN in Fulton Co IN.]

1870 Census, Perry Twp, Miami Co, IN, page 137: Mathew CASE, age 27 OH, farmer; Ellen, age 20 OH; Wm, age 1 IN. [Albert and Ones CASE are listed on the same page with their families.]

1880 Census, Mill Creek, Wabaunsee County, Kansas, page 399 : Matthew W CASE, age 36 OH, farmer, parents born OH; Helen, wife, age 31 OH, parents born PA; Willie, son, age 11 IN; Louis, son, age 9 IN.

Not listed in 1890 Veterans Schedule.

1900 Census Garfield township, Wabaunsee County, KS, page 105: Matthew W. CASE age 57 born Dec 1842 in OH, married 33 yrs., father born OH, mother place born unknown, a landlord; Helen A age 51, born Apr 1849 in Ohio, married 33 yrs, 3 children 3 still living; daughter Myrtle M. age 16 born Jan 1884 in KS.

1910 Census Garfield township, Wabaunsee County, KS, page 129: Mathew W. CASE age 67 born OH, married [1] 41 yrs., no occupation; Helen A, age 60 married 41 yrs, 3 children 3 still living. [Note: Column 30 is marked UA for military service.]

1920 Census Alta Vista town, Garfield Township, Wabaunsee County , KS, page 77: Mathew W. CASE age 76 born OH; Helen A, age 70 born OH; Myrtle M. daughter, single, age 35 born KS.
