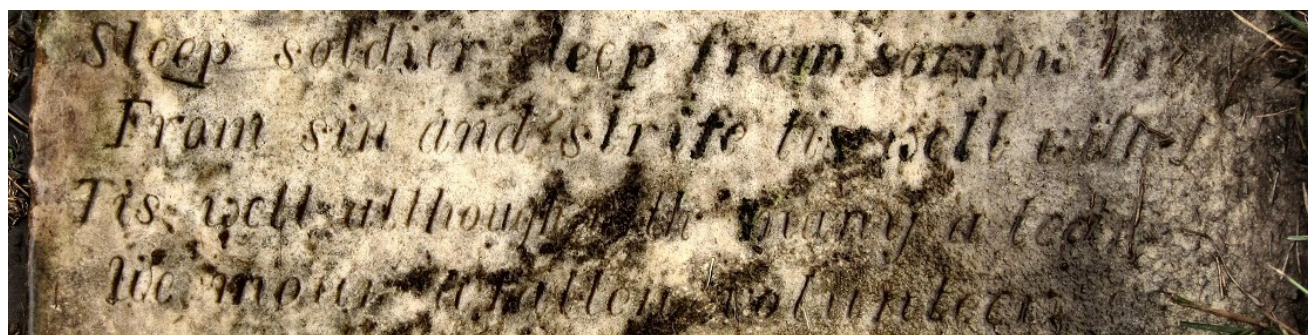


Company E, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

DIEHL, Aaron 23 Sept 1862 *

Private Diehl was age 20 when he entered service. He was discharged 7 Apr 1863 at Miliken's Bend, Louisiana on a Surgeon's certificate of disability. Burial not given.

Death: 4 April 1863

Cemetery: Wooster Cemetery, Wayne Co OH, Section 10A, Lot 304, Grave 1. His stone was lying flat on its back mostly underneath the dirt and grass. 20Yrs, 7mo, 25dys Next to parents.

Grave Registration Card Wayne Co OH: Died at Milliken's Bend, Louisiana on 4 Apr 1863. His stone also has death date as 4 April. Born 1842.
