Gardner, George W.* 14 Aug 1862
Private Gardner was age 22 when he entered service. He died on 28 June 1863 at Jefferson Barracks, Missouri.

The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at St. Louis Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery. [Note: have not found there. Perhaps he was brought home for burial at Congress Cemetery.]

[Jefferson Barracks, St. Louis Co MO: This GARDNER was from Michigan, Co C 12th Michigan Inf. Gardner, George W, d. 09/25/1863, Plot: 31 0 2575, bur. 09/25/1863. So although there is a man by that name buried at Jefferson Barracks is a different person.]

1850 Census, Dover, Tuscarawas Co OH, Dwelling 1128, Family 1136: Reuben GARDNER, age 49 MD, farmer; Charlotte, age 43 MD; William P, age 19 OH, laborer; John H, age 15 OH, laborer; Mary E, age 12 OH; George W, age 9 OH; Louisa J, age 6 OH; Levi F, age 3 OH; Lydia, age 1 OH.

1860 census Congress township, Wayne county OH: Reuben Gardner age 61 born MD, a farmer; Charlotte age 54 born MD; George W age 20 born OH; Louiza J. DULIN age 16 OH [See William DULIN above]; Levi age 13 OH. [Note: At Family Search, Reuben GARDNER who died in Wayne County OH, married Charlotte COOK on 27 Sep 1827 in Baltimore, MD.]

1880 Census, Penfield, Lorain Co OH, Dwelling 61, Family 67: John H. GARDNER, age 45 OH, farmer, parents born MD; Catherine W., age 45 OH, parents born PA; Uri F, age 16 OH, farm laborer; Mary J., age 15 OH, dress maker; Lottie C, age 8 OH; Nellie M., age 6 OH; Charlotte C. GARDNER, mother, widowed, age 74 MD, parents born MD.

Wayne County Probate Court record: George W. GARDNER married Adaline STANLEY on 18 Sep 1862 in Wayne Co OH.

George died from camp fever and chronic diarrhea on 28 June 1863 at St. Louis MO. Also given as died at grand Hospital Jefferson Barracks, MO, 27 June 1863 of fever. Adaline was a resident of Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH. Adaline STANLEY and George W. GARDNER were married 18 Sep 1862. George enlisted at Congress. Died at Grand Hospital, Jefferson Barracks MO on 27 June 1863. His mother was Charlotte C. GARDNER. Mother's address 8 Aug 1884 was Lattasburg, Wayne Co OH. She was a "divorced widow" since fall 1861 and had not remarried. Her husband Reuben had died April 1879. It appears that the mother's request for pension was declined.
