

Company E, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

HOEGNER, John W.* 29 Sept 1862

Private Hoegner was age 18 when he entered service. He died on 21 Nov 1863 in New Albany, Indiana of wounds received in a riot.[date not given]. [New Albany is in Floyd county, Indiana.] [There is another record of John W. Hoegner, age 20, who enlisted in Co I 102nd OH Inf. on 6 Sep 1862, then mustered out on 29 Sep 1862 and enlisted again on 29 Sep 1862. I believe this is the same soldier.]
The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at New Albany, Indiana.

The library in Indiana had no information on such a riot.

"Case. - Private John W. Hogener, Co. E. 120th Ohio Volunteers, received, on board a transport steamer, a blow from an iron bolt, which caused a fracture of the frontal bone. He was admitted to Hospital No. 11 at New Albany, Indiana, on November 18th, 1863, and died, on November 21st, 1863, from compression of the brain. Acting Assistant Surgeon A. M. Clapp reports the case.

Father, William HOEGNER, born Germany. Mother MANDERBAUGH, born PA. Burial Woodlawn Cem. Informant, Mrs. F. W. DAGUE, of Lodi OH.
