HOUGH, William 13 Aug 1862 William A. HOUGH

Private Hough was age 20 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

??Michigan, County Marriages, 1820-1935: William A. HUFF, of Port Huron, married Eunice SHELDON, of St. Clair, 7 Jan 1867 at St. Clair [St. Clair Co], MI. He was age 22 born <1845>. Eunice was age 17, born <1850>. Witnesses were Wilber SHELDON and Eliza SHELDEN. Joseph H. MARSH, Justice of the Peace. [1860 Census, St Clair Co MI: Unice, age 10, listed with Smith and Fanny SHELDON. It appears that Wilber was her brother.]

1870 Census, David and Mary are living in Wayne Twp, Wayne Co OH with some of the children, but William is not with them. Can't find him.

1880 can't find.

Married Martha BROWNELL [or is it BONNELL?]BENNETT

HOUGH, age 66 OH, second marriage, married 21 yrs, parents born PA, own income, Column 30 marked UA for military service; Martha, wife, age 54 NY, second marriage, married 21 yrs, 4 children/4 still living, parents born NY; Vera? ABBOT, daughter, age 22? MI, married, father born OH, mother born NY, winder in silk mill, married under one year, one child/one still living; William ABBOT, grand son, age 3 months, MI, father born IN, mother born MI; Erma HOUGH, daughter, age 18 MI, single, father born OH, mother born NY, winder in silk mill; Cecilia HOUGH, daughter, age 14 MI, father born OH, mother born NY, weaver in silk mill.
