HUSHOUER, Augustus 20 Feb 1864
Private Hushouer was age 18 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 8 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

Wayne County Death Records: August HUSHOWER, age 41, died at Apple Creek OH, 17 Sep 1886, born PA.

Headstones Provided for Deceased Union Civil War Veterans, 1879-1903: Augustus HUSHOUR, Pvt Co E 120th OH Inf. Cemetery: East Union at Apple Creek, OH. Died 17 Sep 1886.

Did not find in Draft Registration.

Cleveland Plain Dealer, Monday, September 20, 1886, page 3: Foretold His Own Death
Wooster, O., Sept. 18 [Special.] Augustus Hurshour, the Applecreek saloonist, who was found dead in bed yesterday morning, was in Wooster on Thursday and told several acquaintances that he believed his death would soon occur. On the same day he applied for membership to the G. A. R. post here, he being a veteran of the 120th regiment, O.V. I.; and had been in Libby Prison and had a good war record. He desired to be a G.A.R. member in order that he could be buried with war honors. On Thursday night he was elected a member of the post and on Friday morning he was dead, dying suddenly from heart trouble." [Available at GenealogyBank]

1850 Census, Brecknock, Berks Co PA, Dwelling 112, Family 126: Joseph HESHAAR, age 29 PA, no occupation; Sarah, age 21 PA; Augustus, age 4 PA; Jerimiah, age 3 PA; Mary E, age 1 PA.

1860 Census, have not found.

Researcher at WorldConnect says: parents were Joseph and Sarah [King] HUSHOUR who moved from PA to Apple Creek. Three children are listed for Joseph: Augustus born 1845 in Brecknock Twp, Lancaster Co PA; Jerimiah and Mary Elizabeth.

Ohio Marriages and Ohio County Marriages: Augustus HUSHOWER married Elizabeth REIDER on 19 Sep 1866 in Wayne Co OH. Event: Wooster.

1870 Census, Village of Apple Creek, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 181: A. HUSHOWER, age 24 PA, hotel keeper; Elizabeth, age 26 OH; Louis [male] age 2 OH; U. WHITMORE, age 26 PA, painter. [Louis B. HUSHOWER born 11 Dec 1867 at Edinburg, Wayne Co OH]

[??Note for family of Augustus: 1870 Census, Village of Apple Creek, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 182: Joe HUSHOWER, age 45 PA, day laborer; Benias [male], age 21 PA, school teacher; Mary, age 19 PA; Angeline, age 17 PA; John age 15 OH; Emma, age 14 OH; Susan age 13 OH; Sarah, age 12 OH; Ephraim, age 10 OH; Phineas, age 5 OH.]

1880 Census, Apple Creek Village, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 171: Augustus HUSHOWER, age 35 PA, saloon keeper, both parents born PA; Elizabeth, wife, age 38 OH, father born PA, mother born OH; Lewis B, son, age 12 OH; Clara A, daughter, age 9 OH; Nola M, daughter, age 7 OH.

Ohio, County Marriages: Augustus HUSHOUR married Ann Jane TASKER on 4 Dec 1884 in Wayne Co OH.

There is a record for a HUSHOUR bride who married Frederick K. FAHLSING in Fort Wayne, Allen Co IN on 19 Oct 1893. It was her first marriage and she was born in Wayne Co OH. Her parents were Augustus HUSHOUR and Elizabeth REIDER.
