KIME, George W. 15 Aug 1862  
Private Kime was age 30 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864.  
Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.

Pension Index: George W KIME, H and F 48th, H 114th, and E 120th OH. Invalid filed 1880 June 28, Application 405323, Certificate 869776. Widow, Sarah L KIME, filed 1896 May 28, Application 634590, Certificate 451490, filed in Michigan.

Thanks to a Kime researcher who helped to find information on George W. KIME. She said, "Clue that helped find George was his burial site... same location as two of his brothers - Pvt James G Kime and John Kime."

Research indicates George W. Kime of the Wayne Co, OH, unit was the son of Jacob Kime who died in Wayne Co in the mid-1830s. Sources include:

Guardianship record for minor heirs of Jacob Kyme from Wayne Co [OH] court, dated Apr 14, 1838: Kyme, Jacob - Maria, John - Mahlon Moyer. bd. Conrad Kyme; Jacob b. Nov 19, 1826; Catherine b. Mar.31, 1829; Eliza b. Jan. 5 1831; George b. Aug. 19, 1837; William b. Aug. 10 1836 - Henry Schuerflager. bd Jac Swartz [I believe the year of George's birth is a transcription error; other records indicate he was born 1832-1833]

1850 United States Federal Census, Marion Twp, Marion Co OH, Dwelling 285, Family 293: Adam BOYER, age 31 PA, farmer; Mariah, age 27 PA; Christiana, age 7 OH; Abraham, age 5 OH; Adam, age 3 OH; Mariah, age one OH; George KIME, age 17 OH, laborer; William KIME, age 16 OH; Elizabeth KIME, age 19 OH.  
Home in 1850: Marion, Marion, Ohio

FamilySearch.org lists George W. Kime (b. 1833) married Sarah L. Stephens (b. 1840) 6 June 1858 in Ingham Co, Michigan.

1860 Census, Alaiedon Twp, Ingham Co, MI; G W Kime, age 27, OH, farmer; Sarah, age 20, OH; Chas H, age 10/12, Mich.

Note: son Frank, born in Ohio; family must have returned to Ohio ca 1862.

1870 Census, Perry Twp, Shiawassee Co, MI; George Kime, age 28, OH, Farm laborer; Sarah, age 28, OH, keeping house; Charles, age 10, Michigan, at school; Frank, age 8, Ohio, at school; Walter, age 3, Michigan.

1880 Census, Porter, Midland County, MI, page 236: George W. KIME, age 49 OH, farmer, parents born PA; Sarah L, wife, age 38 OH, parents born NY; Frank G, son, age 18 OH; Walter D, son, age 18? MI.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Porter and Lee, Midland Co MI: Line 14, House 55, Family 57: George W. KIME, Pvt, Co A [sic], 120 OH Inf. Post Office: Breckenridge, Gratiot co MI. Disability: deaf in left ear.

There is a death record in Michigan, Deaths, 1867 - 1897 for George W. RIME. [I looked at the original and it does look like an R, but it could have been transcribed into the record incorrectly. The other mistake would be his birthplace.] George W. RIME, died 5 Apr 1896 at Porter Twp, Midland Co Michigan. Age 65. Estimated birth year 1831. Born PA. Married. Farmer.
