MILLER, Jacob* 2 Oct 1862
Private Miller was age 28 when he entered service. He died 27 July 1864 at Morganzia Bend, Louisiana. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Port Hudson, Louisiana.

Death: 27 July 1864 at Morganzia Bend, LA

Cemetery: Port Hudson National Cemetery, Zachary, East Baton Rouge Parish, LA Sec D, 2426. I called Port Hudson National Cemetery, and got the correct information.

It is Ja C. Miller, Sec D 2426, Co E 120th OH. But on the stone it indicates that the soldier buried there was in the USCT.....But Jacob was not in US Colored Troops.

Ohio, County Marriages: Jacob MILLER married Angeline JORDON, 30 Mar 1856, Wooster, Wayne Co OH.

1860 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 145, Family 145: Jacob MILLER, age 25 OH, farmer; Angeline, age 25 OH; Joseph E. age 3 OH; Alice, age one OH.

1870 Census.....I don't know what happened to Angeline and children. Benjamin Eason was guardian in 1871, but I can't find the children.

Minor children: Joseph E. born 14 Feb; Alice, born 17 Dec; Jane, born 24 Aug; Effie L, born 21 Aug.

Certificate was dated 24 Sept 1867, Wooster, OH.

Next document says See Minor 200349, 20 Dec 1871. [That would be the Benjamin Eason guardianship.]
