MILLER, Wesley D. 16 Aug 1862 Find a Grave

Private Wesley Miller was age 24 when he entered service. He was captured 10 May 1863 near Vicksburg, Mississippi; returned to company on 27 Nov 1863; transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Mustered out 14 Oct 1865.
