PATTERSON, Samuel* 8 Sept 1862 [Soldiers and Sailors System](#) lists him as Lemuel. Private Patterson was age 18 when he entered service. He was detached in the 7th Michigan Battery on 27 Jan 1863. No further record found. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at St. Louis, Missouri, in Jefferson Barracks Cemetery in section 65 grave 159. It says he died 30 Mar 1863.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: Samuel PATTERSON, Private, Co E 120th OH Inf, died 30 Mar 1863 at Elliot General Hospital, St Louis, MO. Cause: diarrhoea and fever.
