PERSHING, Harmon B. 15 Aug 1862 PERSHING
Private Pershing was age 18 when he entered service. He was captured 3 May 1864 near Snaggy Point on the Red River, Louisiana; mustered out 7 July 1865 at Camp Chase, Ohio.

1880 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County OH, page 54: Harmon B PERSHING, age 38 OH, farmer, parents born PA: Eve, wife, age 28 OH, parents born PA; Ida C, daughter, age 11 OH; Arminda M, daughter, age 4 OH; John C, brother, age 32 OH, carpenter; Olander B, son, age 9 OH. [Note: is Olander=Orlando]

1890 Veterans Schedule: Madison Twp, Lake Co OH: Line 44, House 285, Family 295: Harmon PERSHING, Pvt, Co E 120 OH Inf. Post Office: North Madison, OH. Disabilities: sciatica, rheumatism, back injured by slipping.

1900 Census, Madison Twp, Lake Co OH, page 47: Harmon B PERSHING, age 59 OH, born Oct 1841, married 31 yrs, farmer, parents born PA; Eve, wife, age 48 OH, born Aug 1851, married 31 yrs, 4 children/4 still living, parents born OH; Ruth T, daughter, age 8 OH, born May 1892.

Harmon's son????1900 Census, Village of Cato town, Ira Twp, Cayuga County NY, page 211: Orlando B PERSHING, age 29 OH, single, born May 1871, parents born OH, no occupation listed.

Harmon's daughter???1900 Census, Auburn, Cayuga County NY, page 54: Ida GREENLEE, age 31 OH, is supposed to be on this page, but she must be under the smudges because I can't see her there. According to WorldConnect researchers she would have been a widow then because her husband Edwin B GREENLEE died in 1899.

Harmon's widow and daughters Arminda M.???? and Ruth, 1910 Census, Burbank Twp, Los Angeles County, CA, page 47: Mark S ?????, age 32 OH, married 2 yrs, stenographer in building co; Minnie?, wife, age 33 OH, married 2 yrs, 0 children, parents born OH; Eva PERSHING, mother-in-law, age 58 OH, 4 children/4 still living, widow, parents born PA; Ruth T, sister-in-law, age 17 OH. [Note: WorldConnect researchers say Arminda married Mark S VAN LEUVEN in 1907.]
