Levi REPMAN, born 11 Oct 1842 at Wayne Co OH. Parents: Joseph and Mary [LEET] REPMAN. At age 13 the father, Joseph, came to the US from Germany. Spent time in Pennsylvania and then moved to Canaan Twp, Wayne Co OH, and then to Spencer, Medina Co OH where he and Mary died.

Children: Joseph, Hannah, Sophia, Simon, Jacob, Andrew, Mary, Eliza; John, Sarah [died early] and Levi, the youngest. Levi worked in Ashland OH at age 15 learning to be a miller, then farmed. "In 1862, he enlisted in Co. E, 120th Reg. O.V.T., and served two years as a private." After the war he went to Indiana working at a saw[mill and farming. Then moved to grist-mills in Rochester, PA for 5 yrs. In 1868 he worked at limestone quarry for one year. Leased the Shin, Williams and Co lime kilns for 20 yrs. Was railway engineer for 2 yrs. In 1877 he built a house in Wampum. In 1892 he built a house on thirty acres of what had been the McCullon farm.

He married Elizabeth McCULLON, daughter of Aaron. They had son Harry

and daughter Ida J [SCHNEIDER]. Second wife, Jennie DOUTHETT. They had son Charles. Third wife Maud LOSTETTER, daughter of James.

father 1860 Census, Congress, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 1171, Family 1159: Joseph REBMAN, age 66 Wurtemberg, farmer; Eliza, age 22 OH.

Levi's brother? Levi would have been about 17 or 18 yrs old in 1860.

So this Levi may have been Simon's child.

1880 Census, Wampum Borough, Lawrence Co PA, Dwelling 233, Family 275: Levi REPMAN, age 38 OH, lime burner, father born PA, mother born Wurtemberg; Sarah J., wife, age 27 PA, parents birthplaces not filled in; Harry, J, son, age 10 PA; Ida J, daughter, age 9 PA.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Wampum, Lawrence Co PA: Line 15, House 96, Family 99: Levi REPMAN, Pvt, Co E 120 OH Inf. He served until 10 Sep 1864. Post Office: Wampum, PA. Disability: chronic diarrhoea.

1900 Census, Wayne Twp, Lawrence Co PA, Dwelling 476, Family 492: Levi REPMAN, age 57 OH, born Oct 1842, married 4 yrs, father born Germany, mother born PA, farmer; Maud, wife, age 39 PA, born June 1860, married 4 yrs, 0 children, parents born PA; Charles, son, age 19 PA, born June 1880, single, furniture salesman; Harry J., son, age 28 PA, born Oct 1871, single, at school.

1910 Census, New Castle Rd, Wayne Twp, Lawrence Co PA, Dwelling 66, Family 66: Levi REPMAN, age 68 OH, third marriage, married 16 yrs, father born Germany, mother born PA, general farming, column 30 marked UA for military service ; Maude, wife, age 49 PA, first marriage, married 16 yrs, father born VA, mother born PA.

1920 Census, Ann Street, Wayne Twp, Lawrence Co PA, Dwelling 119, Family 124: Levi REPMAN, age 78 OH, widowed, father born Germany, mother born PA, no occupation; Mery E. McCONAHY, servant, age 65 PA, widowed, parents born PA, house keeper.
