RIDER, John E. 20 Feb 1864  
Private Rider was age 22 when he entered service. He was transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864. Transferred to Co B, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. Discharged 16 Mar 1866.

Wayne County Probate Court record: John E RIDER married Barbara BOTT on 24 Dec 1866 in Wayne County, OH.

1870 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 177: Jno E RIDER, age 26 OH, day laborer; Barbara, age 31 OH; Susanah, age 1 OH. [Note: next dwelling Simon BOTT, age 60 PA, and Anna BOTT, age 56 PA.

1880 Census, East Union, Wayne, OH, page 162: John RYDER, age 29? OH, works by day, father born PA, mother born OH; Barbara, wife, age 41 OH, parents born PA; Savanie, daughter, age 11 OH; Milton, son, age 9 OH; Wallace, son, age 6 OH; Orilla, daughter, age 3 OH; John H, son, age 1 OH.

1900 Census, East Union, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 144, Family 140: John REIDER, age 58 OH, born Aug 1841, married 34 yrs, father birthplace unknown, mother born OH, farmer; Barbara, wife, age 61 OH, born Feb 1839, married 34 yrs, 6 children/5 still living, parents born PA; Milton, son, age 29 OH, single, born Apr 1871, sawmill laborer; John, son, age 21 OH, single, born Oct 1878, farm laborer. [Note: ?brother Christopher REIDER living next door, age 65 OH, divorced, born Aug 1834, parents born PA, farm laborer.]

1910 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 152: John REIDER, age 70 OH, first marriage, married 45 yrs, parents born OH; Barbra, wife, age 71? OH, first marriage, married 45 yrs, 6 children/5 still living, parents born PA; John B, son, age 31 OH, single, day? laborer. [Note: Column 30 looks like it was marked for military service for John Sr.]

1920 Census, East Union Twp, Wayne County OH, page 149: John E RIDER, age 78 OH, widower, farmer on general farm, parents born PA; Wallace E, son, age 45 OH, single, farm laborer, parents born OH; Rilla, daughter, age 43 OH, widow; Morgory M, granddaughter, age 8 OH, parents born OH.

Facts from the obituary: John Rider of Apple Creek, born East Union twp, Wayne county OH, born 15 Aug 1841, died 14 [not correct] Mar 1924, parents Rudy and Eliza Brown Rider, 8 siblings [including Savannah wife of John Foster, Wallace, Rilla wife of CLOUSE, John of home and Milton of Applecreek], 7 grandchildren, 2 great grandchildren, Company E 120th OVI transferred to Co. B, married Barbary Bott, had six children, burial Applecreek cemetery.

The obituary says that he transferred from Company E to Company B. However, he is not listed in the Roster on Company B. Grave Registration Card shows that John was in Co B of the 48th Ohio as well as Co E of the 120th. He was born 15 Aug 1841 and died 10 Mar 1924.

Death Record in Ohio: File #18929, John E. REIDER died at East Union Twp, Wayne Co OH, on 10 Mar 1924. Widowed. Born 15 Aug 1841 in OH. Farmer. Father, Rudy REIDER born PA. Mother Eliza A. BROWN, born PA. Burial Applecreek, OH. Informant, Mrs. Rilla CLOUSE of Applecreek, OH.

My Great Grandfather, Ephraim Rider, was a civil war veteran, serving for the Union with the 187 Ohio Volunteer Infantry. Here are a couple of passages that I obtained from the internet concerning his unit:

Organized March 1, 1865, for one years service, under Colonel And. R.Z. Dawson, it moved at once to Nashville and then to Dalton and Kingston, Georgia. After the close of the war it performed provost duty at Macon. The Regiment was not mustered out until January, 1866.

From Dyer's Compendium

187th Regiment Infantry. Organized at Camp Chase, Ohio, and mustered in March 2, 1865. Left State for Nashville, Tenn., March 3, 1865. Provost duty at Nashville, Tenn., Dalton and Macon, Ga., till January, 1866. Attached to 1st Brigade, 2nd Separate Division, District of
