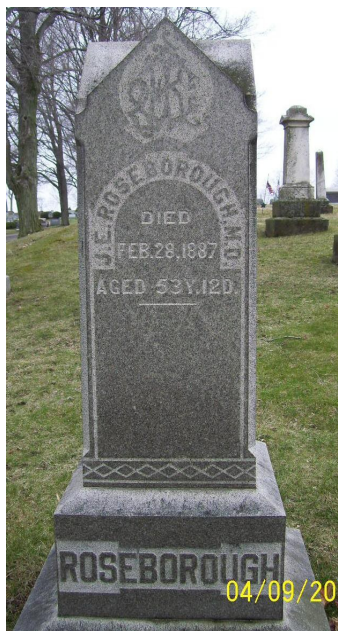


## Company E, 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio Volunteer Infantry



ROSEBOROUGH, Joseph E. 15 Aug 1862  
1st Lieutenant Roseborough's age upon entering service is not given. He resigned 24 Mar 1863. [Joseph E Roseborough, Private, Company C, 16th Ohio Infantry, for 3 months according to the bio below and Soldiers and Sailors System site.]

Pension Index: Joseph E ROSEBOROUGH, E 120th OH Inf. Widow, Calista ROSEBOROUGH, filed in 1890 Sep 2, Application 481068, Certificate 319947, filed in OH. Pension Card. Lt, Joseph died 28 Feb 1887.

Listed in the Wooster Republican on 29 January 1863: At Overton Hospital, Memphis, Tennessee: Lieutenant J E Roseborough of the 120th is listed as convalescent.

Father's Land Patent: John ROSEBOROUGH of Wayne Co Ohio purchased East half of the northwest quarter of section eight in township 21 of Range 14 in the district of lands offered for sale at Wooster, OH, containing 80 acres. 1826 Sep 29? [Note: Twp 21, Range 14 is Congress Twp.]

1850 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling : James McClellan with his family, age 56 PA, farmer; Jane, age 47 PA; Wilson, age 21 OH, farmer; Alexander, age 19 OH, farmer; Nancy, age 18 OH; Harvey, age 15 OH; Amy, age 26 OH; Samuel, age 14 OH; Martha, age 11 OH; Robert, age 9 OH; and then these ROSEBOROUGH children: John ROSEBOROUGH, age 21 OH; Mary A ROSEBOROUGH, age 18 OH; Joseph ROSEBOROUGH, age 15 OH, farmer; William ROSEBOROUGH, age 14 OH.

1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne County OH, page 338: Jane ROSEBOROUGH, age 57 PA?, widow; Joseph E, age 25 OH, teacher in common school; William, age 23 OH, farm laborer. [Note parents of Joseph E at [Find A Grave](#): Jane Ewing ROSEBOROUGH, daughter of Wm ROSEBOROUGH and Agnes EWING was married in 1825 to John ROSEBOROUGH. She died in 1881 and is buried at Congress Cemetery, Congress, Wayne County OH. Her husband John died in 1838. Joseph's siblings were George, Samuel, John W, Mary A, William M, and Erasmus A.]

1870 Census, Shiloh village, Cass Twp, Richland County OH, page 42: Joseph E ROSEBOROUGH, age 33 OH, physician; Jane, age 67 PA.

Ohio, County Marriages: J. E. ROSEBOROUGH married Celesta CLELAND, 4 Oct 1870, Richland Co OH.

1880 Census, Shiloh village, Richland County OH, page 26: J E ROSBOROUGH, age 46 OH, Physician, parents born PA; Celesty, wife, age 30 OH, father born PA, mother born OH; F R, daughter, age 8 OH; M J, son, age 7 OH; B J, son, age 5 OH; Vonnew?Vonview?, son, age 2 OH; H D, daughter, age 4 months OH, born in Jan 1880.

Joseph E., a doctor, was born in Wayne county OH on 16 Feb 1834. He was living in Wooster, OH, when he raised a company for the 120th. In 1866 he moved to Richland County, OH. Wife: Miss Celesta CLELAND.

They had five children at the time of the writing of History of Richland County [1880 compiled by A. A. Graham]. The bio listed him as being in Company C although he is listed in the Official Roster Volume 8 in company E.

Ohio deaths record: J. E. ROSEBOROUGH, died 28 Feb 1887 at Shiloh, Richland Co OH. Age 53. Born 1834 Wayne Co OH. Physician. White, Married.

1900 Census, Hoadley St, Cleveland 7th Ward, Precinct D, Cuyahoga County, OH, page 156: Celia [could be Celeste] ROSEBOROUGH, age 50 OH, widow, born Feb 1850, parents born PA; Milne, son, age 27 OH, single, born Apr 1873, parents born OH, sketch artist; Donald, son, age 18 OH, single, born Mar 1882, engraver, parents born OH; Josephine, daughter, age 13 OH, single, born Mar 1887, parents born OH.
