RUMBAUGH, Adam 15 Aug 1862

Private Rumbaugh was age 19 when he entered service.

He was transferred to Co. H, 114th OVI on 27 Nov 1864.

Transferred to Co F, 48th OVI, 24 July 1865. [No further info in roster.]

Father: Isaac RUMBAUGH

Mother: Mary RUMBAUGH[distantly related]

Birth: May 1843 [20 May 1843....WorldConnect]

Marriage: Catharine SHANK on 30 Dec 1869 in Wayne Co OH

Death: 13 Feb 1906 MI

Cemetery: Ford Cemetery, Bannister, Gratiot Co MI [[Catherine](#) 1851-1919]

Pension Index: Adam C RUMBAUGH, F 48th, H 114th and E 120th OH Inf. Invalid filed 1887 June 28, Application 614636, Certificate 405188, filed in Michigan. Widow, Catherine RUMBAUGH, filed 1906 Mar? 29, Application 846000, Certificate 627416, filed in Michigan. Pension Card: Adam died 13 Feb 1906.

Page 210-211: "Adam C. Rumbaugh...spent the days of his childhood and youth in Wayne county, Ohio, and was a student in the public schools until he had largely mastered the branches of learning therein taught. He was a youth of nineteen years when he responded to the country's call for aid, enlisting on the 15<sup>th</sup> August, 1862, as a member of Company E, One Hundred and Twentieth Ohio Infantry. The regiment was assigned to the western department and the first battle in which he participated was at Champion Hill. [mistaken order here] Later he was in the siege of Vicksburg and was present at its surrender. He also aided in the re-capture of Jackson, in the battle of Arkansas Post, and did active service in Texas and Louisiana along the Red river and in the battle of Fort Blakely. For about two months he was in the convalescent camp at New Orleans and served until the close of the war, when he was honorably discharged and mustered out at Houston, Texas, on the 14<sup>th</sup> of October, 1865. He made a creditable military record, for he never faltered in the performance of any duty whether it called him into the thickest of the fight or stationed him on the lonely picket line."

Father was Adam Rumbaugh, mother was Mary Rumbaugh, distantly related.

Siblings: Susan Clemens, Daniel, Elizabeth Hoch.

Married 28 Dec 1869 to Miss Catherine Shank

1871 moved to Illinois, Effingham county near Altamont

3 yrs later returned to Wayne co OH...farming in Ashland and Wayne for 4 yrs

1879 moved to Chapin, Saginaw county Michigan

4 children: Burtice who married Sophia O'Hare; Martha E at home with parents; Chalmers and Lorinda, deceased. In Saginaw Adam was township treasurer, clerk and justice of the peace, school board for 21 yrs

1850 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 144, Family 146: Isaac ROMBAUGH, age 34 PA; Mary, age 36 PA; Susanna, age 11 OH; Adam, age 7 OH; Daniel, age 4 OH; William, age 1 OH; John HAYNES, age 24 OH, farmer. [Adam's mother could be Mary C KNIGHT....Family Search.]

1860 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County OH, page 313: Isaac ROMBAUGH, age 44 PA, farmer; Catharine, age 39 Bavaria; Susan, age 22 OH; Adam, age 18 OH, farm labor; Daniel, age 15 OH; William, age 12 OH; Elizabeth, age 9 OH; Mary T?, age 3 OH.

Wayne Co OH probate court record: Adam RUMBAUGH married Catharine SHANK on 30 Dec 1869 in Wayne Co OH.

1870 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County OH, page 61: Adam RUMBAUGH, age 27 OH, farmer; Catherine, age 19 OH.

1880 Census, Chapin, Saginaw County, MI, page 55: Adam RUMSBAUGH, age 36 OH, farmer, can't read parents birthplaces; Catharine, wife, age 29 OH, parents born PA; Lucinda, daughter, age 5 OH; Lamburitis, son, age 2 OH.

Not on 1890 Veterans Schedule

1900 Census, Chapin Twp, Saginaw County, MI, page 153: Adam RUMBAUGH, age 57 OH, born May 1843, married 31 yrs, farmer, parents born PA; Catherine, wife, age 49 OH, born Dec 1850, married 31 yrs, 4 children/2 still living, father born MD, mother born PA; Burtus?, son, age 22 OH, born Sep 1877 farm laborer; Lizzie, daughter, age 14 MI, born Nov 1885.

Michigan, Deaths and Burials: Adam RUMBAUGH died 13 Feb 1906 at Village of Elsie, Clinton Co MI. Age 62. Born <1844>. Farmer. Married. Father Isaac RUMBAUGH. Mother Mary RUMBAUGH.
