SHOUP, William H.* 13 Aug 1862

Private Shoup was age 20 when he entered service. He was killed 1 May 1863 in the battle of Thompson's Hill, Mississippi. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Cemetery: Vicksburg National Cemetery [not listed] Stone at Burbank Cemetery, Co OH.

There is a stone for a Civil War soldier Shoup, W.H. died 1863, at Burbank cemetery, Wayne county OH, died 1 May 1863, age 20 yrs, 6 months. His brother's name is on the same stone: C.W. Shoup, died on the Steamer Sultana, 28 Apr 1865, age 21.

Wooster Republican 28 May 1863: Casualties in the 120th Ohio: Wm H. Shoup, killed.

Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865: William SHOUP, Private, Co E 120th OH Inf, died 1 May 1863. Place not given. Cause: killed in battle.

Not on National Cemetery Interment Control Forms, 1928-1962

Have found no pension index record.

1850 Census, have not found.

1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne County OH, page 338: George SHOUP, age 44 PA, a farmer; Catherine, age 44 PA?; John age 21 PA?, teacher in common school; William, age 18 PA?, teacher in common school; Charles, age 16 PA? [*This must be the CW who died on the Sultana*]; Caroline, age 11 PA?; Thomas, age 8 PA?; Sarah J, age 6 PA?.

[Catharine SHOUP, 1816-12 Oct 1883, wife of G. W. SHOUP, buried at Burbank Cemetery, Wayne Co OH.]
