STINEHOUE, Jacob 15 Aug 1862
STINEHOWER
Corporal Stinehouer's age upon entering service not given. He was appointed 26 Jan 1863; transferred to Co. B 23d Regiment, Veteran Reserve Corps, 6 Nov 1863; mustered out 19 July 1865 at Clinton, Iowa.

Birth: 16 May 1833, Germany
Memorial stone says 1837.
Marriage: Martha FLACK on 13 Mar 1860 in Wayne County OH

Death: 3 Mar 1880, NY
Cemetery: Green-Wood Cemetery, Brooklyn, Kings Co NY, Lot 31445, Section 206. Martha and some children also buried there. See Find a Grave. Martha died 1898.

Wayne County Probate Court record: Jacob STINEHOWER married Martha FLACK on 13 Mar 1860 in Wayne County OH.

1860 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 306: Jacob STEINHOWER, age 27 Hess, laborer; Martha, age 23 OH.

Moved to NY by <1864> when Cora was born.

1870 Census, 22nd Ward Brooklyn, Kings County, NY, page 664: Jacob STINEHOWER, age 37 Germany, foreman in flour mill; Martha, age 33 OH; Orill O, age 7 OH; Cora M, age 4 NY; Frank L, age 2 NY; unnamed male, age 6 months NY, born in March.

NY, cash boy in store, father born Germany, mother born OH; Harry O, son, age 10 NY, cash boy in fancy store, father born Germany, mother born OH; Ira I?, son, age 7 NY, father born Germany, mother born OH; Charles C, son, age 5 NY, father born Germany, mother born OH.

1890 Census, Veterans Schedule, Brooklyn, Kings County, New York: Line 12: House 747?, Family 133, Martha widow of Jacob STINEHOWER, Private, Co G 23 ?KY? Vol, Co E 120th OH Vol., Aug 1861 to Feb 1864, post office address Brooklyn NY/Wayne Co OH, death caused by chronic bronchitis.

1900 Census, 6th Avenue, 22 ward Brooklyn, Kings County, NY, page 222: the children Orrill [born Oct 1872], Cora [born Oct 1877], Harry [born Mar 1870], and Charles [born Feb 1874] are all living together. An Aunt, Sarah FLACK, age 61 OH, is also living there. She is single, so that verifies Martha's maiden name. 1910 Sarah FLACK and Cora are still living together in Brooklyn.
