SULLINGER, Jacob* 15 Aug 1862

Private Sullinger was age 27 when he entered service. He was discharged on 7 Nov 1863 at New Orleans, Louisiana, on a Surgeon's certificate of disability; he died on 17 Dec 1863 at Cairo, Illinois. The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Mound City, Illinois.

1850 Census, Plain Twp, Wayne County, OH, page 361: John SULLINGER, age 47 Switzerland, farmer; Mary A, age 50 Switzerland; Susanna, age 18 Switzerland; Elizabeth, age 17 Switzerland; Jacob, age 14 Switzerland.

1860 census Plain Township, Wayne County OH: John SULLINGER age 48 born Switzerland, a farmer; Mary Ann age 59 born Switzerland; Elizabeth age 26 born Switzerland; Jacob age 24 born Switzerland. [father John Sullinger died 21 Oct 1867 at Plain, Wayne Co OH]
