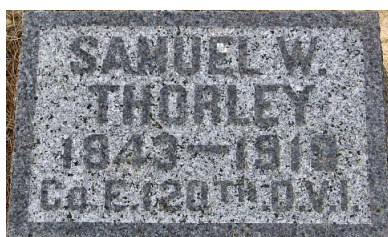

THORLEY, Samuel W. 15 Aug 1862
Private Thorley was age 19 when he entered service. He was discharged on 15 Mar 1863 at Memphis, Tennessee on a Surgeon's certificate of disability.

1850 Census, Congress, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 286, Family 291: William THORLEY, age 35 VA, farmer; Catharine, age 31 VA; John G., age 8 OH; Samuel W., age 7 OH; Harriet, age 5 OH; Matilda, age 2 OH; William M., age 11 months.

1860 census Congress Township, Wayne County OH: Wm THORLEY age 45 born VA, a farmer; Catherine age 41 born VA; Jno T age 18 OH; Sam'l W age 16 born OH; Harriet age 15 OH; Matilda age 12 OH; Wm W. age 11 OH; Lewis M age 4 OH, Serepea E [female] age 1 born OH.

In 1870 Congress Township Wayne County OH, I believe that the "Hess" listed with his father the Wm Thorley family is Samuel. He is listed as age 26 born OH and is a harness maker.

Wayne County Probate Court Marriage Records: Samuel W. THORLEY married Hannah C McFADDEN on 15 Feb 1877 in Wayne County OH.

1890 Veterans Schedule: Line 44, House 263, Family 264: Samuel THORLY, Pvt, Co E 120 OH Inf. Post Office Lattasburg, OH. Disability: Heart trouble and epilepsy. Discharged in Washington.

1900 Census, Chester Twp, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 256, Family 257: Samuel THORLEY, age 51 OH, born June 1842, married 28 yrs, parents born OH, grocery merchant; Hannah, wife, age 49 OH, born Apr 1851, married 28 yrs, 5 children/4 still living, parents born OH; Seppie, daughter, age 22 OH, single, born Jan 1878, servant; Lloyd, son, age 20 OH, single, born Nov 1879, in school; Clyde, son, age 14 OH, born Dec 1885; Clara, daughter, age 14 OH, born Dec 1885.

1910 Census, Chester Township Wayne County OH: Samuel THORLEY age 66 born OH, a harness maker, parents born WV; Catherine wife age 59, born PA, married 33 yrs, 4 children, 4 still living; son Clyde age 24 OH, a carpenter, single, parents born OH.

Samuel Thorley Is Dead At Lattasburg

Samuel W. Thorley, well known old soldier passed away Thursday evening at his home in Lattasburg after a short illness from a stroke of paralysis which he sustained Monday morning.

The deceased was 76 years of age and leaves a wife and four children. Clyde Thorley of this city, Lloyd Thorley living near Wooster, Mrs. Clara Firestone of Greenwich, Ohio and Mrs. Seppie McQuigg of Ashland. Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon, meeting at the house at 1:30 o'clock.
