

Company E, 120th Ohio Volunteer Infantry

WAGNOR, Isaac* 15 Aug 1862 James WAGGONER
Private Wagnor was age 33 when he entered service. He was killed 1 May 1863 in the battle of Thompson's Hill, Mississippi.

The Roll of Honor lists him as being buried at Vicksburg, Mississippi.

Wooster Republican 28 May 1863: Casualties in the 120th Ohio: Isaac Wagner, wounded and since dead.

Wayne County Probate Court record: James WAGGONER married Harriett MARSHALL on 10 Jun 1854 in Wayne County OH.

???There was Peter WAGGONER in Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH in 1840.

1860 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne County OH, page 328: Isaac WAGGONER, age 31 OH, gunsmith; Harriet WAGGONER, age 39 PA; Orlando WAGGONER [MALE], age 6 OH; Dan'l MARSHALL, age 18 PA, harness maker; Joseph MARSHALL, age 16 PA, farm laborer; Margaret MARSHALL, age 14 OH; Martha MARSHALL, age 12 OH; Sarah MARSHALL, age 10 OH.

1870 Census, Congress Twp, Wayne Co OH, page 151, Dwelling 47, Family 48: D. K. FRANCE, age 49 PA, grocer; Charlotte, age 48 PA; Idilla WAGONER, age 10 OH. [Note: I don't know where Orlando was that year, but by 1880 he was married with children. He died in Akron OH on 29 Nov 1930. His birthday was listed as 15 Sep <1853>. He was buried at Congress Cemetery. His marker says born 15 Sep 1854. Wife Rachel YOUNG.]

Ohio, County Marriages, 1789-1994: Idella WAGNER married John F. HARTSEL on 6 Jun 1878 at Wayne Co OH.

1880 Census, Congress, Wayne Co OH, Dwelling 58, Family 59: Daniel K. FRANCE, age 59 OH, grocer, parents born PA; Charlotte, wife, age 58 PA, father born PA, mother born NJ; John F. HARTZELL, age 26 OH, harness maker, parents births not filled in; Idella, wife, age 20 OH, father born PA, mother born OH; Lottie M, daughter, age one month OH, born May 1880. [John H. HARTZEL born 2 Aug 1854, died 13 Dec 1882, buried at Reedsburg Cemetery, Wayne Co OH.]

Ohio, Deaths and Burials, 1854-1997: Lola HARTZEL died 22 Sep 1901 at West Salem, Wayne Co OH. Born 24 May 1880 at Congress. Occupation: music teacher. Single.

Pension Index: Isaac WAGONER, Co E 120th OH Inf, 5 June 1863, Application 23601, Certificate 12239, for minor pension, D. K. France is the name given.

Pension filed for Isaac WAGONER of Co E, 120th 5 June 1863 in OH. This was a pension for minor children Idella and Orlando. Address of guardian was Congress, Wayne Co OH. The guardian was Daniel K. FRANCE, age 41, resident of Congress Wayne Co OH. Orlando was born 20 Sep 1854 Wayne Co OH, or 15 Sep 1854. Idella was born 19 Jun 1860 Wayne Co OH or 29 July 1860. They were Isaac's only children. James WAGGONER and Harriet MARSHALL were married 10 Jun 1854 at Wayne Co OH. Was in Battle of Port Gibson. Harriet died 7 May 1862. Isaac was wounded in battle of Thompson's Hill, MS on 1 May 1863 and died 2 May 1863.
